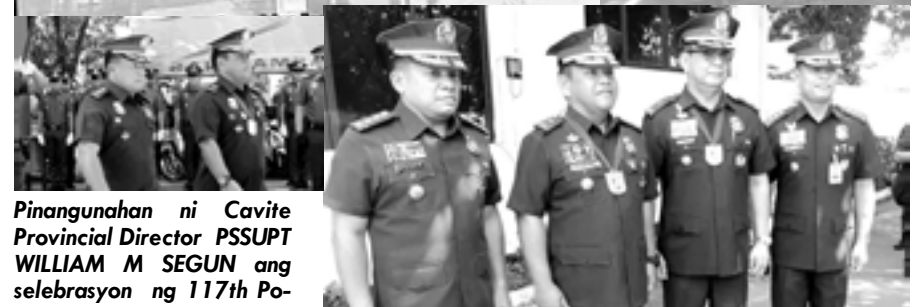

PNP CALABARZON IMPLEMENTS MAJOR RESHUFFLE OF OFFICERS

Camp Vicente Lim, Laguna -The Police Regional Office CALABARZON or PRO4A issued relief and re-assignment orders Thursday among

its officers in the region.

CALABARZON comprises the provinces of Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal and Quezon.

PRO4A Regional Director Chief Supt Edward Carranza said affected in the revamp is 1 Senior Superintendent, 27 Superintendent, and 2 Chief Inspectors who were re-assigned to different areas within the region.

Laguna Provincial Director Sr Supt Kirby John Kraft was replaced by Sr Supt Eleazar Matta.

The Chiefs of Police of major cities like Calamba, Tanauan and Lipa were also replaced.

Carranza said the reorganization is the result of the regular performance assessment of the region by the Oversight Committee Members on Illegal Drugs and Illegal Gambling and the Enhanced Managing Police Operations composed of the Regional Investigation and Detective Management Division, Regional Operations and Plans Division, Regional Police Community Relations Division, Regional Intelligence Division and Regional Personnel and Human Resource Development Division headed by its Chairman and Deputy Regional Director for Operations Sr Supt Marlon Madrid.

The said assessment of the performance of the Chiefs of Police covers the period from June to September 2018.

"We in PRO4A is still at its peak in terms of our anti-criminality and illegal drugs campaign in line with President Rodrigo Roa Duterte's directive and with our Chief PNP, Dir Gen Oscar Albayalde's leadership

focus on the eradication of illegal drugs in our country. Despite our strong standing, we will not rest on our laurels but instead we want to make sure that our men on the ground especially our Chiefs of Police could deliver what is expected of them and if not then we will replace them with those who could." Carranza also said.

Further, the said reshuffle is part of the routine system in the PNP wherein those who already met the maximum two (2) years of tenure as Chief of Police will be relieved from the said position. There are also those who were transferred due to career advancement.

"Movement of our officers will ensure a more balanced, efficient, and productive leadership in their new assignments. It is also our policy in the PNP to look into the career advancement of our officers. This is part of preparing them for their future assignments especially as managers and leaders. We want to make sure that we put the right person on the right job where they could perform their best in serving the community," Carranza further added.

Carranza further sent letters to the Local Chief Executives informing them of the relief of their COPs and re-assignment of new officers in their respective cities/municipalities.

"I have the full trust and confidence to these officers that they will lead by example for their people on the field and expect them to deliver effectively," the Regional Director added.

PTFoMS LAUNCHES HANDBOOK ON SECURITY MEASURES FOR MEDIA WORKERS

MANILA-The Presidential Task Force on Media Security (PTFoMS) on Thursday launched a handbook meant to provide media

professionals with precautionary measures to ensure their safety during coverage. PTFoMS has started distributing the handbooks to Mindanao-based journalists in Cagayan de

Oro City during a seminar on the implementation of Administrative Order No. 1 (A01) formulated and signed by President Rodrigo Duterte.

President Duterte lauded the PTFoMS' latest development, stressing that the media remains one of the "hallmarks" of a vibrant democracy. "My warmest greetings to the Presidential Task Force on Media Security as it releases the Handbook on the Personal Security Measures for Media Practitioners," Duterte said in a statement.

"I am confident that this handbook will be a valuable material as it propagates best practices that will enhance the security of every stakeholder in the industry," he added.

The handbook was launched in line with the PTFoMS 2nd anniversary

celebration.

Justice Secretary Menardo Guevarra said the handbook is "a huge step forward in the realization of the President's promise of establishing a community where press freedom and democracy not only survive but actually flourish."

"I applaud everyone whose hard work, dedication, and contribution made this handbook a possibility," Guevarra said.

Communications Secretary Martin Andanar, meanwhile, acknowledged the efforts of PTFoMS Executive Director Joel Egco for spearheading the project, noting that media professionals can use it to confront the "journalist jungle."

Egco, on the other hand, encouraged media professionals to know the handbook's contents by heart.

"This handbook was primarily designed to be with you 24/7, but we

encourage you to commit to memory its contents, especially the Philippine Journalists' Code of Ethics," Egco said.

He also reminded media workers to give primary importance to their safety.

"No one is more concerned with the protection for your life and safety than you are. Therefore, the greater the effort you put into the task, the greater will be the degree of your safety," Egco said.

The PTFoMS was created through Administration Order No.

01 signed by President Rodrigo Duterte in October 2016 to address media killings and harassments.

It is headed by the Department of Justice, co-chaired by the Presidential Communications Operations Office, with the Department of National Defense, Department of the Interior and Local Government, Office of the Solicitor General, Presidential Human Rights Committee, Armed Forces of the Philippines, Philippine National Police and National Bureau of Investigation, as members.
