

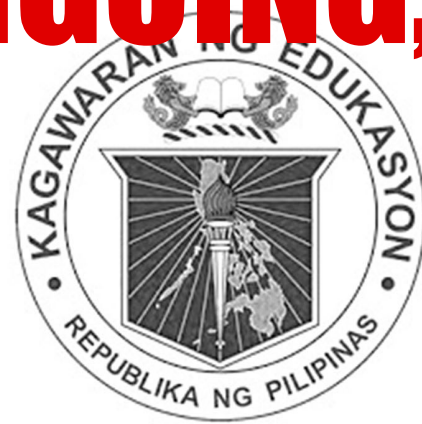

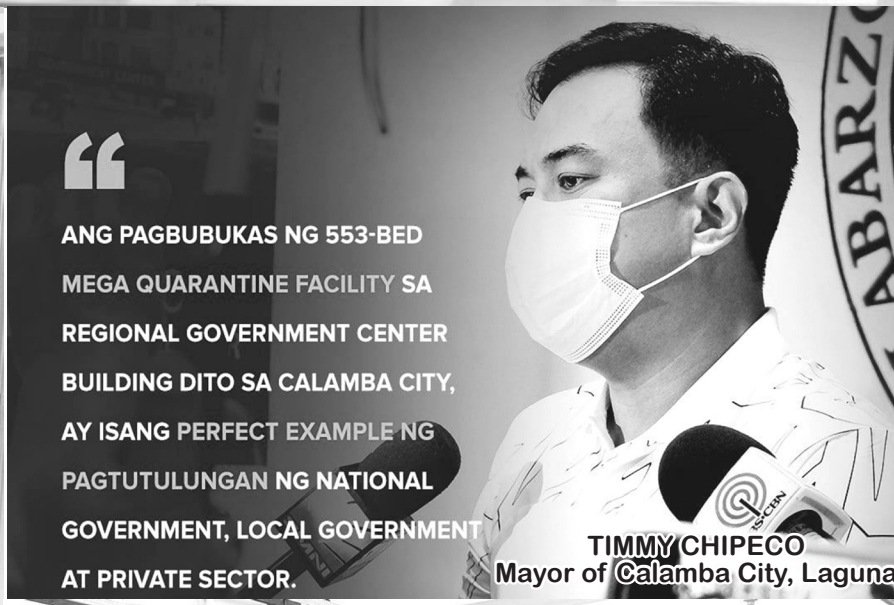

Mega Quarantine Facility sa Calamba bahagi ng pagpapaunlad sa health system capacity



CALAMBA CITY, LAGUNA - Sinabi ni Department of Health Sec. Francisco Duque na ang itinatayong bagong Mega Quarantine sa Lungsod ng Calamba ay bahagi ng pagpapaigting ng gobyerno sa health system ng bansa.

Sa mensahe ni Sec. Duque nang mag-inspeksyon ang National Task Force (NTF) Against COVID-19 sa Calabarzon Regional Government Center na kasalukuyang ikino-convert bilang isang Mega Quarantine Facility sa naturang lungsod, binigyang diin niya ang kahalagahan ng naturang pasilidad sa inisyatibo ng pamahalaan na palakasin pa ang kapasidad ng sistemang pangkalusugan laban sa Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19).

“Ito po ay bahagi ng aming pagbibisita para siguruhin po na ang



ating health systems capacity ay atin pong pinaunlad at pinaigting at nakita naman po ninyo na ito ay karagdagang 553-bed capacity ng isolation and quarantine facility,” pahayag ng Health Secretary.

Kaakibat aniya ang hakbang na ito sa limang haligi sa pagtugon ng pamahalaan sa suliraning dulot ng pandemyang COVID-19.

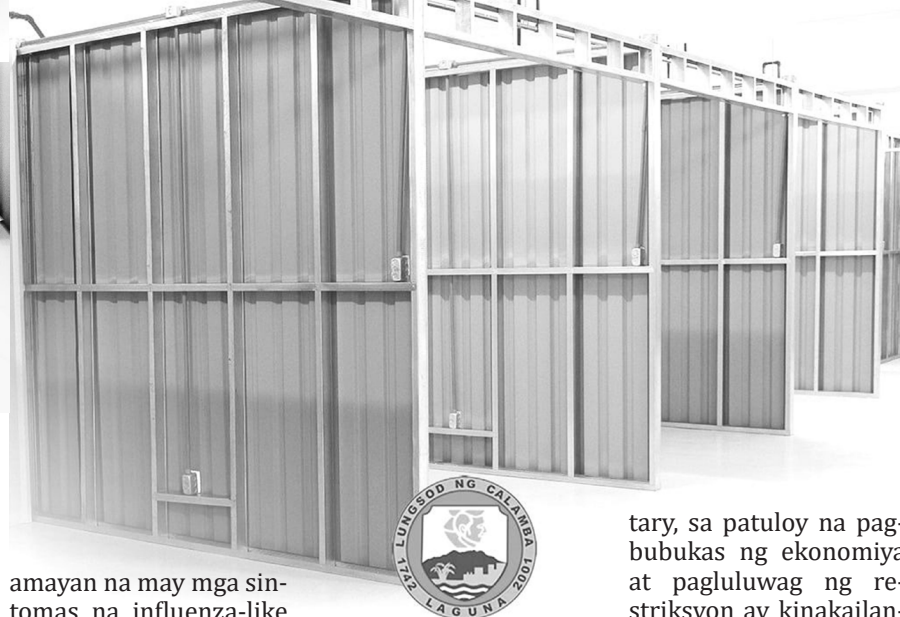
Ang limang ito aniya ay ang mga sumusunod: (1) prevention, (2) early detection through aggressive active case finding, (3) contact tracing, (4) testing, at (5)

isolation.

“Ito iyong facility na sumusuporta po doon sa isa sa mga humahaligi sa atin na pandemic response, kasama po ang treatment,” dagdag pa ni Sec. Duque.

Bahagi naman aniyang katuwang ng pamahalaan pagdating sa treatment ang mga ospital, ang one hospital command center na binuo nito lamang nakaraang tatlong Linggo, at mga quarantine/isolation facility.

Sa ilalim naman ng Oplan Kalinga, ayon sa Health Secretary, ay inililipat ang mga mam-



amayan na may mga sintomas na influenza-like illness (ILI) at may mga nag-uumpisang acute respiratory illness sa mga pasilidad na gaya ng Mega Quarantine Facility sa lungsod ng Calamba na sa ngayon ay 80 porsiyento nang kumpleto.

“Layunin po nito na sila ay agarang mailipat sa ganitong mga facilities kasama po ang mga ospital. Ito po ay bumubuo sa tinatawag nat-

ing referral, one effective patient navigation and referral system.”

Nagpaabot rin si Sec. Duque ng pasalamat kay Laguna Gov. Ramil Hernandez at Calamba City Mayor Timmy Chipeco sa kanila aniyang agresibong pagpapaunlad ng mga pasilidad na makikita nga sa nasabing quarantine facility.

Dagdag pa ng Secre-

tary, sa patuloy na pagbubukas ng ekonomiya at pagluluwag ng restriksyon ay kinakailangan na ang pamahalaang nasyunal at lokal ay magkatuwang na magsikap upang makayanang tugunan sakaling tumaas ang bilang ng mga kasong severe hanggang sa kritikal na COVID-19.

Ang naturang pasilidad ay inaasahang maaari nang tumanggap ng pasyente sa huling Linggo ng buwan ng Agosto.

DOST II DISTRIBUTES 5,000 FACE SHIELDS TO PLGU-CAGAYAN



Tuguegarao City – In support of the Resolution released by the Inter-Agency Task Force for Emerging Infectious

Diseases (IATF-EID) encouraging the use of face shields in all places, the Department of Science and Technology Region 02 led by Director Sancho A. Mabborang pro-

vided 5,000 pieces of face shields to Provincial Local Government Unit of Cagayan on August 24, 2020.

These face shields were fabricated by the

DOST- Metals Industry Research and Development Center (DOST-MIRDC) to support medical and non-medical front liners nationwide.

Aside from the protection for the eyes,

nose, and mouth that it gives, the face shields are also believed by the local researchers as a convenient protection from the transmission of the virus.

These face shields

were officially awarded through Engr. Sylvia T. Lacambra, PSTC-Cagayan Director, John Michael Taguiam, SRS II, Jayferson Mabborang, SRS II, and Ferdinand Michael, SRS I. (PAPI)

distance learning are ongoing nationwide.

"Most of the school divisions offices of respective regions have already conducted their respective dry runs and simulations," said DepEd Undersecretary Revsee Escobedo citing data as of Aug. 24.

Dry-runs and simulations for blended/distance learning, Escobedo said, are being conducted in various DepEd regional offices (ROs) and school division offices (SDOs) nationwide to ensure the readiness of schools,

teachers, and students for the School Year (SY) 2020-2021 opening.

DepEd data showed that over 100 SDOs have conducted their dry-runs and simulations before Aug. 24. Some SDOs have also scheduled dry-runs prior to the Oct. 5 school opening.

"Most of them have completed the dry-runs but they are doing it again because of the gaps they saw during the dry-runs and they will try to improve these," Escobedo said in a mix of English and

Filipino.

Aside from the gaps, Escobedo said that some of the regional offices have also identified "best practices" that emerged during the dry-runs in their division offices. For instance, in Region 10, the schools noted that the use of Electronic Learner Enrollment and Survey Form or E-LESF is helpful in tracking or monitoring their students.

"The E-LESF significantly provides for more efficient information dissemination and

more accessible learners' profile," Escobedo said. "And because of this, our teachers will not have a hard time developing the weekly home learning plan."

Escobedo noted that there are also ROs and SDOs that continuously conduct dry-runs and simulations to fill possible issues or gaps when the school opening formally starts.

"Dry runs are being held at the school level to eliminate or minimize the issues during the past dry runs or address gaps and to

observe the implementation of their newly-developed learning continuity plans and systems," he explained.

The conduct of dry-runs and simulations, Escobedo noted, helped increase the number of enrollees in some regions.

"Dry runs boosted the confidence of the parents that their children will have opportunities to continuously learn through various learning modalities amidst the COVID-19 situation," he said.

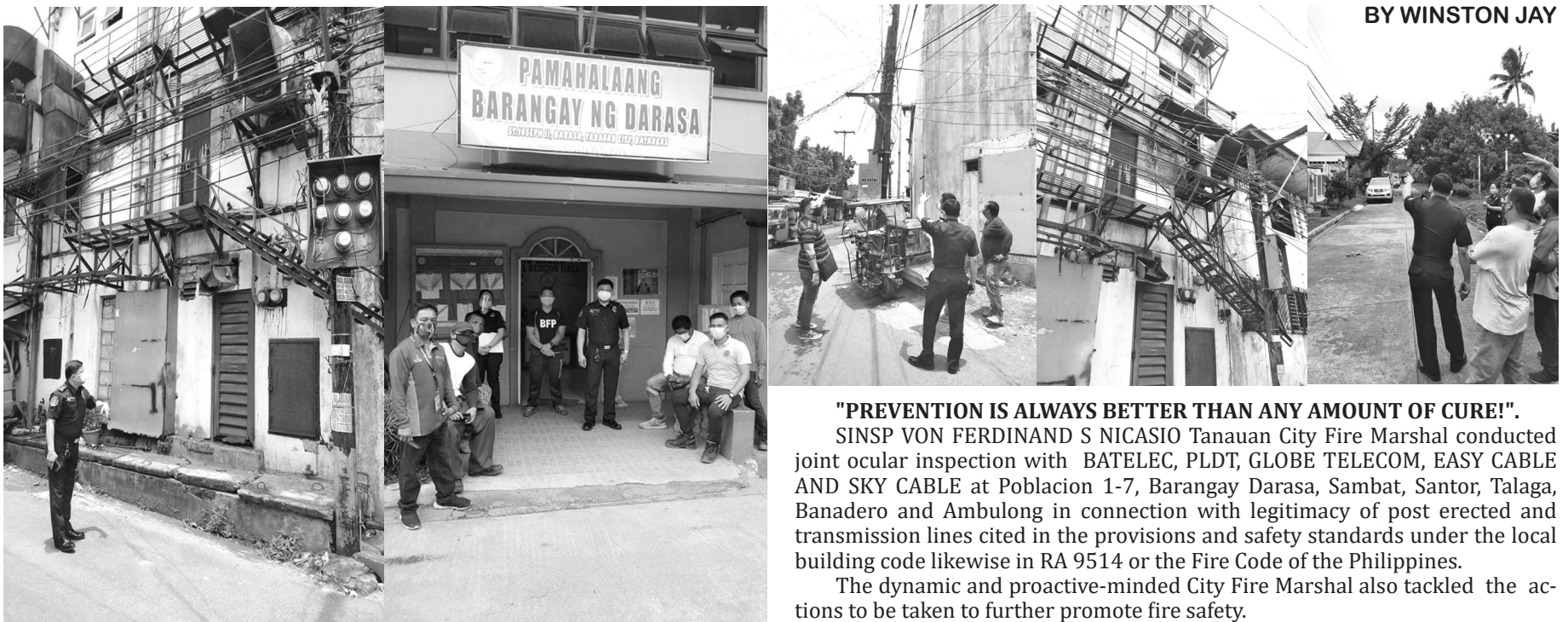
Escobedo noted

that in Region VIII, for instance, "numerous parents have become confident right after witnessing the simulations in the regions and they decided to enroll their children for this coming school year."

DepEd national enrollment data as of Aug. 28 showed that the total number of enrollees for School Year (SY) 2020-2021 has reached 23.91 million in both public and private schools. This, DepEd said, is 86.03 percent of the total enrollment in SY 2019-2020. (MB)
