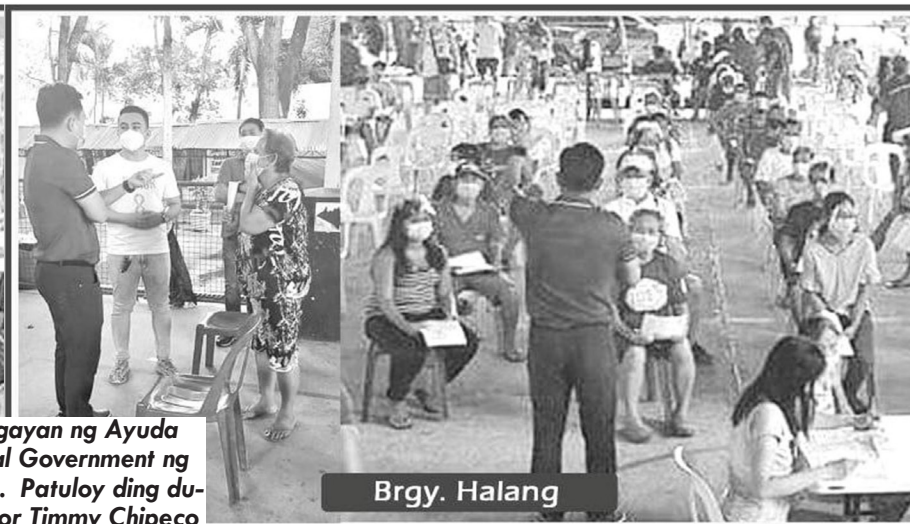

ng COVID-19 ay maiugnay sa naturang variant. "As we have been predicting for several weeks now, the Delta variant...has established itself as the dominant variant circulating, as it has done in more than 163 other countries," ani Aneyasinghe.

Sinabi niya na ito ay "hindi nakakagulat" dahil sa mataas na transmissibility ng Delta variant, dahil inaasahan na din ito na mahigitan pa at tumindi pa ang maging epekto nito kaysa sa mga naunang variant sa bansa.

"What we are seeing here in the Philippines is not unique. That's been seen in many other countries, with this kind of transmission, with this kind of numbers, we are in community transmission with the Delta variant," paliwanag niya. Kinumpirma din ni Abeyasinghe na ang Pil-

ipinas ay nakakaranas ngayon ng "community transmission" ng Delta variant, dahil sa mataas na transmissibility at infectiousness nito. Nauna rito, kinumpirma ng Department of Health (DOH) ang Community transmission ay mula sa National Capital Region (NCR) at CALABRAZON.

Ngunit itinuro ni Abeyasinghe na dahil sa "mga maagap na hakbang," ang bansa ay nagawang "maiwasan sa ngayon, dulot ng mga bagong healthcare facilities."

Sinabi niya na ang iba pang mga kadahilanan ay kasama ang maagang pagpapatupad ng mga "community lockdown" at ang napakabilis na pagtaas sa pagbabakuna.

May ilang eksperto din na nagsabi na ang pagkakaroon ng Community Lockdown ay naging isang dahilan upang bahagyang mapigilan o mabawasan

ang kaso ng mga may Covid-19 o Delta variant sa Pilipinas.

Noong Agosto 29, iniulat ng DOH na nasa 516 ang mga bagong kaso ng Delta variant, na ang kabuuang 1,789. Sa 516 na kaso, 473 ang lokal na kaso, 31 ang nagbabalik sa ibang bansa ng mga Pilipino, at 12 kaso ang kasalukuyang napatunayan kung ito ay mga lokal o ROF na kaso.

Ipinakita sa datos na mula sa 473 mga local cases, 114 na kaso ang nagmula sa NCR, habang 24 na kaso ay mula sa rehiyon ng Ilocos, 32 kaso sa Cagayan Valley, 64 kaso sa Central Luzon, 79 kaso sa Calabarzon, 20 kaso sa MIMAROPA.

Mayroon ding 16 kaso mula sa Bicol Region, 13 kaso sa Western Visayas, 23 kaso sa Central Visayas, 12 kaso sa Zamboanga Peninsula, 48 kaso sa Northern Mindanao, 22 kaso sa Davao Region, at anim na kaso sa Cordillera Administratibong Rehiyon.

DTI Cavite and Noveleta LGU tie-up to benefit more LSP NSB Beneficiaries

On 31 August 2021, DTI Cavite, through its Livelihood Seeding Program – Negosyo Serbisyo sa Barangay, and the Local Government of Noveleta, through its Tulong Puhunan, distributed livelihood kits to 40 micro enterprises in the four barangays of Noveleta, Cavite namely Brgy. Poblacion, Magdiwang, Sta. Rosa, and Salcedo II.

The kits consisted of merchandise, tools, and equipment for sari-saristores, tapsihan, coffee and milk tea shops, refreshment and kakanin stores, carinderia, bakery, water station, computer shop, car aircon supply, vulcanizing shops, salons, and general merchandise stores.

For the LSP-NSB in Noveleta, five MSMEs from each selected barangay have been selected as beneficiaries of the program. 20 MSMEs were initially identified to be given livelihood kits to help them improve their business in this time of pandemic. However, seeing the importance and the great impact of the LSP-NSB, Hon. Mayor Dino Chua doubled the number of beneficiaries in every barangay, adding 20 more livelihood kits to be given under their Tulong Puhunan program.

"This is the first time in CALABARZON that a local government unit made an initiative to fully support our LSP-NSB program through adding more livelihood kits for more beneficiaries. This action introduces a best practice for LGU Noveleta, and we hope that others would follow suit and expand their assistance to our program," said DTI CALABARZON Regional Director Marilou Q. Toledo.

"With this, I hope our beneficiaries will become good role models by being passionate and innovative entrepreneurs who can sustain their businesses amid the challenges of the pandemic," added RD Toledo.

Mayor Chua, on the other hand, announced that there will be more distributions to take place in other barangays to cover more MSMEs. Along with District 1 Board Member Davey Chua, he guaranteed the continuous support of Noveleta LGU for future

projects of the DTI.

Intending to help the country's base of the pyramid during the pandemic, DTI developed the LSP-NSB to support a grassroots approach to enterprise development, increasing the awareness of Barangay Officials about the services offered by the Department through its Negosyo Centers and delivering business development assistance and services in barangays.

To make sure that the said goal will be realized, DTI Cavite OIC Provincial Director Revelyn A. Cor-

tez pushed for more capacitated MSMEs by encouraging the beneficiaries to actively participate in the training sessions conducted by the DTI, especially the activities organized by Negosyo Centers.

As of 31 August 2021, 151 livelihood kits have already been awarded to the beneficiaries of LSP-NSB in Cavite.

ports that of the over 900,000 teaching and non-teaching personnel of the Department of Education, only 80,792 have received their first dose of COVID-19 vaccine while only 53,045 have received their second dose as of August 11.

"Malapit nang magbukas ang klaseng unit madami pa din sa ating mga guro ang hindi pa nababakunahan. Pano naman 'yung mga naghahandle ng blended learning na regular na nakikiharap sa mga magulang para magdistribute ng modules? Kaya dapat maisama sila sa priority list," he said.

The former legislator also cited some of the teachers' grievances, such as delayed release of benefits and reimbursements on top of being overfatigued due to being overloaded with paper works and reports, that should be addressed immediately

to enable them to cope with the stress brought by the new learning systems amid the coronavirus pandemic.

"Delayed na mga benefits nila, sila pa ang sumasagot ng gastos para sa internet nila, at pati 'yung reimbursements para sa pagprint ng modules, delayed pa rin. May mga pamilya rin silang kailangan suportahan at hindi naman kalakihan ang kanilang sweldo," he said.

Internet access and cost on top of heavier workload confronts public school teachers, the same problems encountered by students, according to the survey conducted by the Movement for Safe, Equitable, Quality and Relevant Education (SEQuRE Educ Movement).

As the new learning systems, both full online and blended learning, would still be in place with the COVID-19 pan-

demic still raging, the quality of education in the country would suffer if the teachers are hindered from giving their best.

"Paano naman sila makakapagturo ng maayos kung problema na nganila ang unstable at mabagal na internet, ngarag pa sila sa dami ng reports at paper works na kumakain pati oras ang kanilang pahinga? Di pa sila nakakatanggap ng tamang benepisyo on time," the former lawmaker said.

Based on the study conducted by the same group on public school students, it showed that only 14% of the respondents learned well under the new learning

system, while 66% to 86% said they learned less under either full online learning or blended learning, respectively.

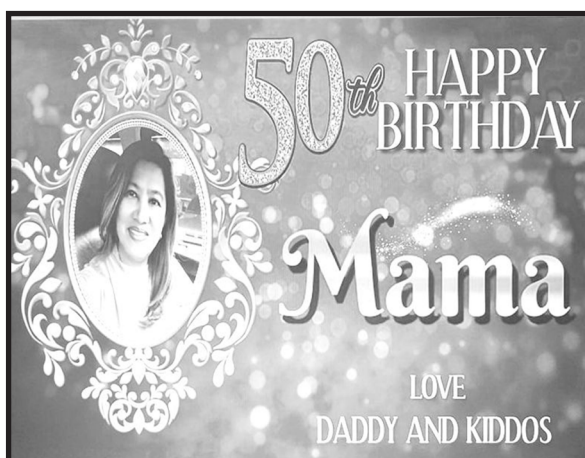
Now with only two weeks before the opening of classes, total enrollees is still only 35.1% at 9,197,265 as of August 26, compared to the 26,227,022 enrollees last year.

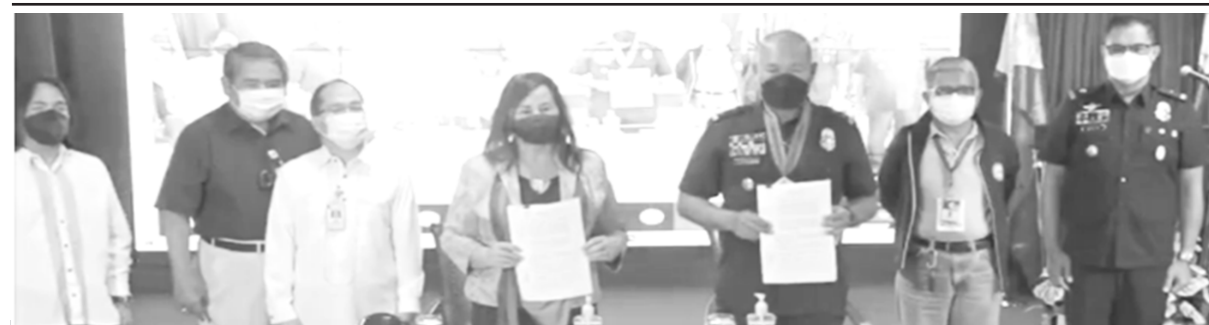
