COVID-19 VACCINATION ROLLOUT IN CAVITE



The province of Cavite started its COVID-19 vaccination rollout on March 10, 2021 at the Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital (GEAMH) in Trece Martires City. GEAMH is one

of the official vaccination sites in the province identified by the Department of Health-Regional Office, among others were De La Salle University Medical Center, Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital, Ospital ng Imus and Tagaytay

International Convention Center.

Three hundred eighty-nine Sinovac vaccines and ninety-one Astra Zeneca vaccines were delivered on March 9, 2021 which were used in the vaccination rollout scheduled until

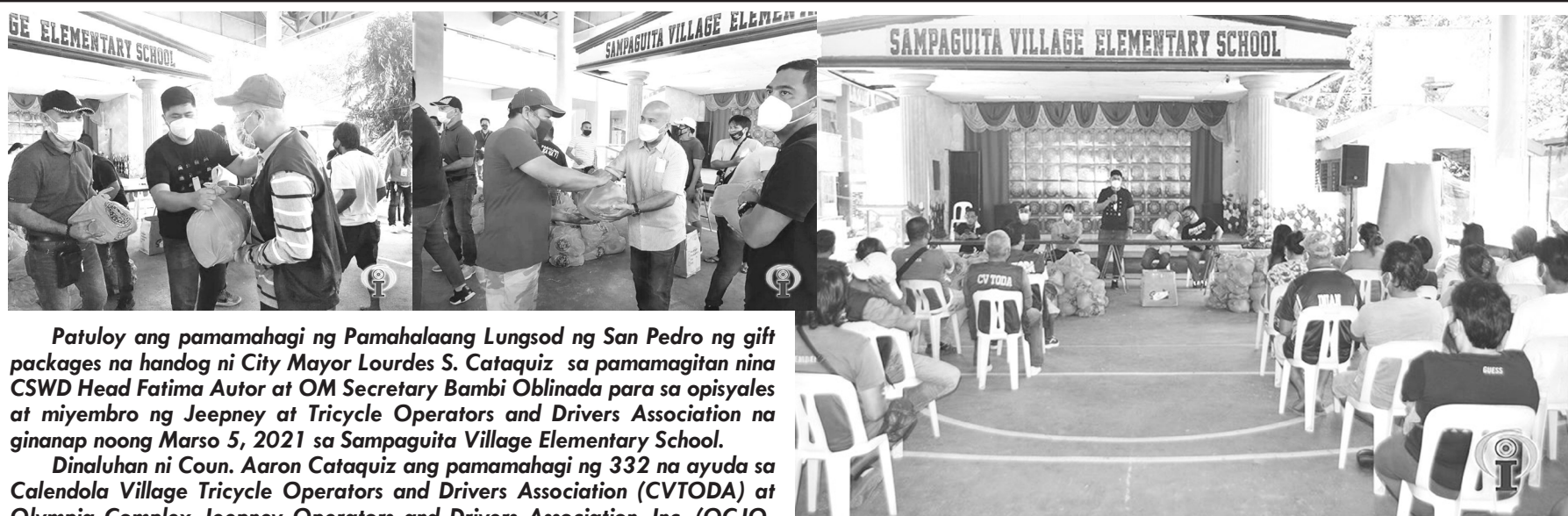
March 12. Among the first vaccinees were Dr. Nonie John Dalisay, Officer-in-Charge of the Provincial Health Office, Dr. Romulo Lua, chief of hospitals, Dr. Aldous Angeles, satellite hospitals chief and Dr. Regina B. Salazar, head-GEAMH Dental Department.

They thanked the government for providing vaccines for the medical front liners and encouraged the public to be vaccinated for them to be protected against the virus as well as their families and other people. Around 150 vaccinees is targeted on the

first day of vaccination.


The process started at the waiting area where candidates for vaccination took the cue to proceed to the next step at the registration area to fill up and check necessary requirements. They then

COVID-19 vaccinations a requirement for returning to work.

"That cannot be made mandatory. It's up to the employee if they want to get vaccinated or not," Bello said in Filipino, adding that the policy that is supposedly cropping up in some companies is discriminatory.

He said that businesses that would impose a "no vaccination, no work" policy could face an administrative penalty since there is "no legal basis" for such a requirement.

"It will be considered as illegal suspension or illegal dismissal, whatever action the employer would do if the employee does not get vaccinated," he said.

According to a Business World report citing

a survey by global advisory firm Willis Towers Watson and the People Management Association of the Philippines, a majority of companies are already moving to procure vaccines for their workers. The survey of 250 human resource practitioners found that "as many as 68% of employers said that they would fully subsidize the cost of vaccines, while 11% said they would partially pay for the doses."

'Emerging' policy Associated Labor Unions, the largest

group of labor unions in the country, sounded the alarm about what it described as an "emerging" policy of some businesses requiring their workers to get vaccinated against COVID-19 before they are allowed to return to work.

ALU said that some factory workers have complained to them about how their superiors have told them that they would not be allowed to report to work unless they participate in the company-sponsored coronavirus vaccination drive.

It added that other business owners have given instructions to supervisors and managers to deem employees who do not get vaccinated against COVID-19 as unfit to work.

It also said that another group of employees have been told

that they would need to present a certification to prove that they have received a COVID-19 job before they are allowed to work.

Meanwhile, Iloilo City is mulling to mandate all employees in the city to get vaccinated against COVID-19 be-

fore they are allowed to work.

While the government targets to inoculate 60 million to 70 million people in the hopes of achieving herd immunity, it is not making COVID-19 vaccines mandatory.

DOH-CALABARZON AND BACCOOR CITY GOVERNMENT SIGNS 5-YEAR DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR STRH

The Department of Health (DOH) - Calabarzon (Cavite, Laguna, Rizal, Batangas, Quezon) and the City Government of Bacoor formally signed the implementation of the "5-Year Development Plan 2020-2025" for the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital.

"The development plan will serve as a guide in preparing the future expansion of STRH to become a reliable regional providing every citizen the high-

est possible quality of health care that is accessible, efficient, equitably distributed, adequately funded, fairly financed, and appropriately used by an informed and empowered public as the first step to promote the Universal health care and achieve the national dream of "Walang Pilipinong Maiiwan". And we will be implementing this with the coordination and the support of the City of Bacoor," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated in his message.

"As a health and medical institution for the disadvantaged and an excellent provider of care for the critically-ill patients, STRH has initiated the desire to deliver health and medical care that are responsive to the needs of the population in line with the demands of the modern times."

"With the 5-year development plan, we aim to position STRH in one of the centers of excellence in the region delivering medical services from a highly skilled and stable workforce and superior health care service for the public at affordable cost," he emphasized.

"And eventually, magiging isang special-

ized medical center sya and also evolved into a regional training and teaching hospital complete with a research and development unit to conduct research into improved service delivery for the implementation of technologies that are cost effective."

The resources required to execute the strategies for the 5-year development project is estimated at P500M. STRH will be developed from its present 65-bed capacity level 1 to a 200-bed capacity level 2 as stated in its regional hospital roadmap.

At present, STRH is designated as the vaccination site for the Province of Cavite together with the General Emilio

Aguinaldo memorial Hospital (GEAMH), Ospital ng Imus (ONI), and the De La Salle University Medical Center for the coming vaccination rollout by the government.

Dr. Ruby Ephraim M. Rubiano, STRH Chief of Hospital has initiated reforms and spearheaded the accomplishments in the expansion of the hospitals medical and health services.

Through his leadership, he established the following services Tele-Medicine and TeleDentistry, Women and Child Protection Desk, STRH Command Center for Patient Referral, Mother and Baby Friendly Hospital Unit, provision of ICU and Respiratory Unit, opening of Outpa-

tient Clinic during the Covid 19 pandemic and opening of the vaccination center, expansion and opening of the clinical laboratory and ongoing construction of the molecular laboratory, worked for the approval of STRH plantilla positions and implementing the "NO REFUSAL POLICY".

He also effected the establishment of a Malasakit Center for STRH and prepared the Five Year STRH Development Plan.

The plan will prepare STRH for the challenges of the future while ensuring a coordinated direction towards the needs and desires of the people of CALABARZON.

of the wetland park does not only helps us keep safer grounds against flashfloods especially during typhoons but promotes sustainable development.

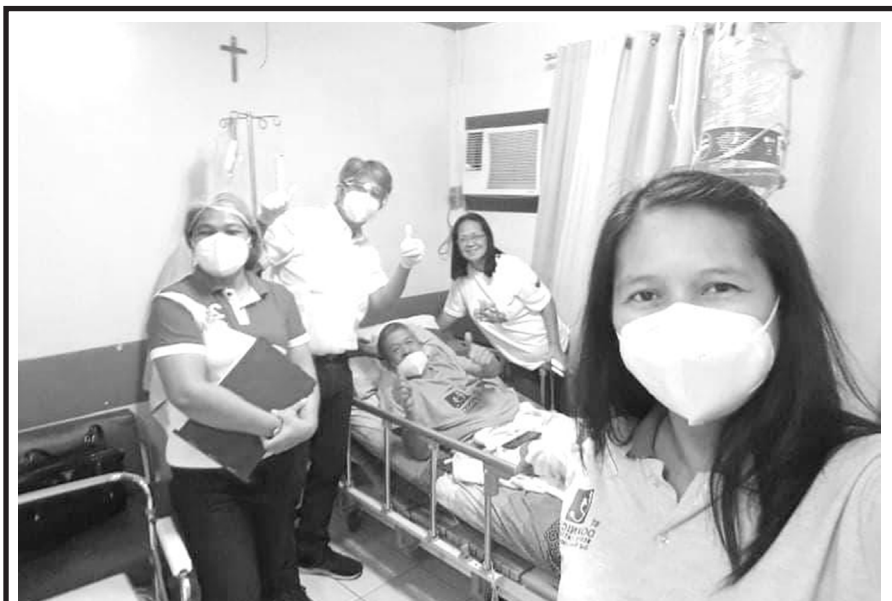
