**Marcos vows to improve work conditions of Filipino nurses**

MANILA – President Ferdinand “Bongbong” Marcos Jr. on Thursday said his administration is committed to raising the profile and improving the working conditions of nurses here and abroad.

He made this commitment in a speech during his attendance at the 100th anniversary celebration of the Philippine Nurses Association, Inc. at The Manila Hotel.

“As part of our goal to raise the profile and

improve the working condition of nurses, we seek to address the disparity in salaries between government hospitals with those in the private sector,” he said.

“Also, we must address the uneven distribution of nurses in different areas around the country. In order to do that, we have to address issues related to health facilities, benefits, and security of tenure,” he added.

Marcos acknowl-

edged that the current salaries of nurses in the Philippines need to be raised, but noted that the government may not have available funds to cover this yet.

“Medyo hirap tayo sa pondo ngayon, kaya’t sa ngayon ganyan lang muna. Pero palagay ko... binibuhay nyo ang may sakit e, ibang usapan yan. Mahirap lagyan ng balor, ng dolyar, ng piso yung trabahong ginagawa ninyo (We are still short of funds now, that’s

why that will have to do for now. But I think...because you are caring for the sick, that’s a different story. It is difficult to put a price tag on the job you do),” he said.

He noted that his office is “always open” to dialogue to address the issues concerning nurs-

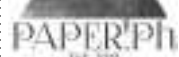

"Depressed na siya, gusto na niyang umuwi nang Nueva Ecija. Eh wala pang pamasaha, kaya naka-ilang attempt nang tumakas sa kanila, sa anak niya. Sa pamamagitan nang paglalakad, gusto niyang makauwi sa Nueva Ecija," ani Angue.

Habang naglalakad sa hindi maliwa-

## ONE TIME BIG TIME OPERATION IN CALABARZON NETS 444 WANTED PERSONS

**C**amp B Gen Vicente P. Lim, Calamba City - The CALABARZON Police successfully arrested a total of 444 individuals by virtue of valid warrants of arrest in a day.

The PNP leadership opting to send a firm message to criminal elements that the police are working and they will never be able to evade the arms of the law forever, have given a directive to all police units to conduct a simultaneous service of warrants of arrest.

PRO4A Regional Director Brig Gen Jose Melencio Nartatez Jr. conveyed his appreciation to the men and women of his office for the support they have shown to the efforts of the police organization to address criminality. He also emphasized that almost half of these wanted persons have committed grave offenses and with their arrest the general public can feel more safe in the comfort of their homes and even on the streets.

"Their relentless effort to deliver more

than what is expected from them have really manifested how a united goal can reach boundless limit. The PNP is more than one can imagine and your police can work untiringly to attain its purpose of finding, suppressing, and holding these criminals accountable for the crimes they have committed," he said.

Among the 444 total arrested individuals with warrant, 125 are listed as Most Wanted Persons, with breakdown as follows based on the level of their listings: 14 Regional Level; 23 Provincial Level; and 88 City/Municipal Level. The remaining 319 were listed as other wanted persons. Most of the crimes violated that caused the issuance of warrants of these individuals are Homicide, Rape, Murder and Violation of Republic Act No. 9165 and for that the Regional Director had given specific instruction on how his men will further seize the opportunity to nab more offenders in the future.

Based on the report, Rizal Police Pro-

vincial Office have demonstrated excellence, putting behind bars a total number of 147 wanted persons, but based on percentage, number of standing warrants versus number of arrested persons, Quezon Police Provincial Office led.

Nartatez shared the success on these police operations to the members of the community and Barangay Information Networks, that have helped the PRO CALABARZON in gathering information as to the whereabouts of these fugitives of the law.

"We have seen before that individuals who have committed crimes, more so of heinous nature, would likely commit again another crime in the future, if they were given no intervention and for that we seek the assistance of our stakeholders to come up with programs that will help criminals to restrain their impulsive actions once confronted with difficult situations and to help them also to reintegrate back to their communities and families." Nartatez added. (ROSELLE AQUINO)

es and allied healthcare professionals.

Marcos also promised to open more slots to the deployment of nurses abroad while striving to improve domestic opportunities.

In terms of legislation, Marcos backed the passage of House Bill 9389 or the New Philippine Nursing Practice Act" which was recently approved by the House of Representatives on final reading and will be submitted to the Senate for action.

"I have taken special note of the clamor to address issues in the nursing profession by the passage of the New Philippine Nursing Practice Act. This Executive Department together with Congress will work with you to achieve these goals," he said.

As of Aug. 19, Marcos said the government has disbursed a total of PHP25.82 billion worth of benefits to healthcare workers, especially nurses.

These include hazard duty pay, Covid-19 sickness and death compensation, meals, accommodation and transportation allowances, life insurance, special risk allowance, and the One Covid-19 allowance.

Programs for nurses.

Marcos said the government will also continue to pursue programs that support the continuous development of Filipino nurses such as the Nursing Certification program which strengthens and certifies our nurses' competencies in various specialty areas.

He said the Primary Care Workers Certification program, which provides eligibility requirements, standard competencies, training mechanisms, and certification processes that ensure competent and quality staffing for our healthcare system, will also be offered.

Marcos said they will also support the Leadership Development Courses for Public Health Nurses which aims to capacitate nurses to provide quality health services and become skilled leaders and managers.

The In-Service Post-Graduate Scholarship Program, which will enhance nurses' competencies through formal education, and the E-learning program, which provides access to free, continuing professional development, and accredited courses in many many disciplines of study, will also continue to be provided.

Filipino nurses' compassion and kindness. Meanwhile, Marcos praised expressed gratitude for the sacrifices and contributions of all Filipino nurses.

Speaking from his own experience after contracting Covid-19 twice, Marcos said he witnessed how Filipino nurses risked their lives to care for the sick and even opted not to return to their homes to avoid spreading the virus to their families.

"During my fight against Covid-19, I benefited from the able and healing hands of competent Filipino nurses.

because of you, and this I cannot stress more, because of you and the sacrifices that you made knowing that there is a risk involved, but because of that sacrifice, because of that compassion, because of that professionalism our nation has survived the most difficult moments of this pandemic," he said.

He said Filipino nurses stood out from others not just for their competence and dedication, but for their "compassion and kindness."

"Marami namang magaling diyan ngunit kahit yung mga foreigner hinahanap nila, mas gusto nila na ang nag-aalaga sa kanila mga Pilipino na nurse. At hindi naman kataka-taka dahil kapag alagaan ka ng Pilipino na nurse gagaling ka talaga (There are so many excellent nurses, but even foreigners prefer being taken care of by Filipino nurses. And there is no surprise there because if a Filipino nurse takes care of you, you will surely recover," he said.

He also said it was a pleasure to attend the PNA's 100th anniversary because his father, the late President Ferdinand Marcos Sr., also attended the association's golden anniversary.

Founded in 1922, the association was established to promote professional growth towards the attainment of the highest standard of nursing.

The anniversary celebration coincides with the 65th Nurses' Week Celebration and its National Annual Convention 2022. (PNA)

# Reform PITC and its twin PS-DBM – Recto



**RECTO**

Procurement Service of the Department of Budget and Management's (PS-DBM) "controversial twin", the Philippine International Trading Corp. (PITC), should also be "disenfranchised as a parking lot of billions in government funds," House Deputy Speaker Ralph Recto said.

"The parking lot is actually a duplex, the PITC being the other one," Recto said.

According to Recto, the PITC, a Department of Trade and Industry agency, need to go back to its original mandate as a state international trading arm, undertaking countertrade or importing essential goods for mass distribution by the government such as medicine and fertilizer,

not as a local procuring arm of other government agencies that it has failed to do so.

The PITC failed to deliver on time the tens of billions of pesos worth of goods, equipment and infrastructure it was contracted by hundreds of government agencies to buy "for a fee."

PITC's unreturned advances amounting to P33.2 billion from 79 government transactions had not been delivered until the end of 2019, with still a backlog value that slightly went down to P31.5 billion, involving 61 contracts in the subsequent year.

The latest COA 2021 report revealed that around P14.9 billion of public funds are still being held by PITC "in trust for government agencies for the procurement of various items."

The top 5 agencies with "parked funds" at PITC that have pending orders worth more than P1 billion each, are: Bureau of Fire Protection, P2.66 billion;

Philippine Army, P2.23 billion; DICT, P2.19 billion; Bureau of Customs, P1.33 billion; and, DOH, P1.19 billion, Recto said. Other agencies with unpurchased items worth more than P500 million are: Philippine Navy, P947 million; TESDA, P783 million; UP-PGH, P687 million; and, PNP P507 million.

Recto emphasized that based on the mandate of the requesting agencies, "you can surmise that these are essential goods, such as medical equipment from UP-PGH and DOH, or fire prevention equipment or building from the BFP."

"Ang matindi dito ay itong sa Bureau of Fire. May mga pondong 2015 pa na-transfer sa PITC, pero ang tagal bago na-deliver," Recto said.

In October 2020, at the Senate floor, the Senator Recto had already raised the issue on the PITC's failure to complete not even one of the 98 fire stations it was contracted to build at a budget of P892 mil-

lion. "Three years ago, P3.27 billion na ang utang ng PITC sa BFP. But as of last December, meron pang balance na P2.66 billion. Anyare?" Recto asked.

Sana naman yung P997 million worth of fire trucks, aerial ladders and various equipment undelivered as of end of 2019 would have been delivered to BFP by now, he added.

As part of procurement reforms, Recto called on the Marcos administration to disauthorize the transfer of expiring agency allotments to PITCs.

"This loophole which is used to extend the life of allotments that expire at the end of the year, and prevent their return to the Treasury, should be plugged," Recto said.

He also stressed that this "pasa-buy" type of government procurement has resulted in delivery delays, overpriced purchases and substandard goods.
