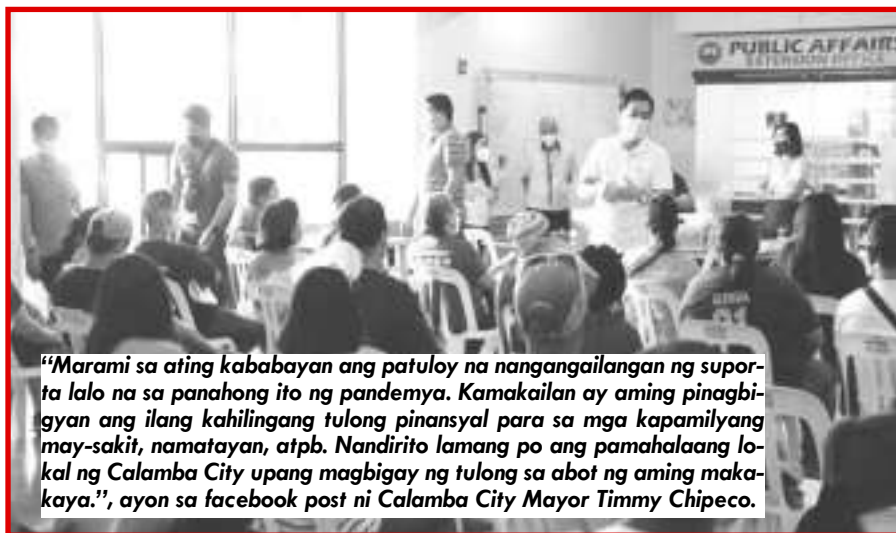

usher in a reformation of the country's political party system and ensure that membership is based on principles, and not just on the party's influence.

In an ambush interview in Marawi, Lanao del Sur, Robredo was asked if she will push for a two-party system. Robredo said that it would necessarily be the case, but she would prefer

that politicians do not just jump on the bandwagon — or the party of the winning president.

"Alam natin kung ang nangyayari sa atin elections after elections. Iyong sa atin dito halos hindi nabibigyan ng value iyong mga political parties kasi dito sa atin, ang paglipat ng partido ay para kang nagpapalit lang ng damit, na kung ano iyong convenient sa

iyong, iyon iyong gagawin mo," Robredo told reporters after an event in the city.

"Hindi naman iyon iyong role ng political parties. Kasi ang role ng political parties, dapat ito iyong nagpo-provide ng platform para iyong mga advocacies mo at saka iyong principles na tinutulak mo, iyong party iyong pinaka-representation ng mga prinsipyong iyon," he added.

In the past two presidencies — that of

late former president Benigno Aquino III and incumbent President Rodrigo Duterte — politicians jumping from one party to the ruling party became common.

In 2010, after Aquino won in the elections, elected officials including members of the Congress jumped ship from their respective parties towards the Liberal Party (LP), which was the late leader's party. Then after Duterte won in 2016, LP members moved to PDP-Laban, which is the current president's party.

Robredo said that allowing such a system does not help in the public's political maturity, especially if the goal is to involve the people more in political discussions.

"And hindi siya nakakatulong sa political maturity ng mga tao. Iyong para sa akin, kung pagdedesisyunan nating ayusin iyong political party system, kailangan mag-umpisa iyon sa electoral reforms," she explained.

"Kailangan bigyan ng mas malawak na participation iyong ordinaryong mamamayan para iyong mga politicians kagaya namin ay nagiging sensitive sa pakiramdam ng mga constituency na pinaninilbihan namin. And hindi siya convenient lang dahil sa pagkakandidatura namin," she added.

As a testament to her commitment to party reforms, Robredo said she would not discriminate against politicians

based on party lines if she is elected president — which means officials are free to support her, without pressure to join LP.

"Para kasi sa akin, opportunity para gawin na natin iyong maraming pagbabago politically na dapat baguhin. Very important element ng progress ng ating bansa kung iyong politics natin ay maayos din. Alam natin hindi nakakatulong iyong pag-shift ng loyalties. Hindi naman kailangan nasa partido ka ng presidente para maging supportive ka," she said.

"Iyong party ko is just one of the parties doon sa political system. Sa akin, it doesn't make sense na grabe iyong reklamo ko sa klase

ng politika natin tapos kapag ako nakaupo, gagawin ko rin, 'di ba? So sa akin, ang Liberal Party naman kahit maliit siya, basta ipinaglalaman niya iyong kaniyang mga paninindigan, that is enough," she added.

Robredo is running in the 2022 presidential race against labor leader Ka Leody de Guzman, Manila Mayor Isko Moreno, Senators Manny Pacquiao, Panfilo Lacson, and Ronald dela Rosa, and former senator Bongbong Marcos.

Before she filed her certificate of candidacy, Robredo vowed to unite the opposition to prevent a government similar to President Duterte's, and block the return of the Marcoses to power.

## Ilang LGUs sa Laguna, nilimitahan ang paglabas ng mga di bakunado

**C**ALAMBA CITY, Laguna — Nasa pitong lokal na pamahalaan sa Laguna ang naglabas ng kautusan at ordinansa na nagtatakda ng regulasyon sa paglabas ng mga hindi pa bakunadong indibidwal.

Ito ay sa gitna ng tumataas na aktibong kaso ng Covid-19 sa lalawigan na ngayon ay umabot na sa 3,941 batay sa datos ng Laguna Provincial Health Office.

Kabilang dito ang pamahalaang lungsod ng Biñan at mga pamahalaang bayan ng Los Baños, Kalayaan, Mabi-

Magdalena, Pagsanjan, at Pila, ayon sa ulat ng Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Region 4A.

Ang paglilimita sa paglabas ng mga hindi pa bakunadong indibidwal ay kasunod ng pagtatakda ng Metro Manila Council ng ordinansa tungkol dito dahil sa nararanasang pagtaas ng kaso ng Covid-19, sa pagsisimula ng taong 2022.

Sa Biñan City na naglabas ng kanilang ordinansa kamakailan, hindi pinapayagan ang paglabas ng mga hindi pa bakunado maliban

na lamang kung ito ay bibili ng mahahalagang pangangailangan o serbisyo, o di kaya naman ay papasok sa trabaho.

Hindi rin sila papayagan na mag dine-in sa mga indoor at al fresco restaurants maging sa loob ng mall, hotel, events, place, sports venue at iba pang katulad na pasilidad.

Itinatag rin ng nasabing ordinansa ang pagbabawal sa mga unvaccinated individuals sa mga pampublikong transportasyon maliban na lamang kung bibili ng mahahalagang pangangailangan o serbisyo, papasok sa trabaho, o

para sa pangangailangang medikal.

Nakasaad rin sa ordinansa na kailangang magpakita ng negative RT-PCR o rapid antigen test result kada dalawang linggo sa kanilang personal na gastos ang mga manggagawa na hindi pa ganap na bakunado bago payagang makabalik sa trabaho.

Ang mga establisimyento na makikitaan ng paglabag ay pagmumultahin ng P3,000 para sa unang paglabag, P5,000 at suspensiyon ng business permit at pansamantalang closure order para sa ikalawang paglabag. Nasa P5,000

at kanselasyon ng business permit at closure order naman ang naghihintay sa establisimyo para sa kanilang ikatlong paglabag.

Pagmumultahin din ng P500 ang mga hindi pa bakunadong indibidwal na hindi tatalima sa mga probisyong nakasaad sa ordinansa para sa unang paglabag, P1,000 para sa ikalawang paglabag, at P3,000 para sa ikatlong paglabag.

Sa ngayon, nakataas pa rin sa Alert Level 3 ang buong lalawigan ng Laguna na iiral hanggang Enero 31 batay sa desisyon ng Inter-Agen-

cy Task Force Against Covid-19.

Nauna nang hinikayat ng Regional Task Force Against Covid-19 Calabarzon ang mga lokal na pamahalaan sa rehiyon na i-adopt ang resolusyon ng Metro Manila Council.

Sa kabuuan, may 14 na lokal na pamahalaan sa buong rehiyon ang nagpatupad na ng kaparehas na ordinansa habang 23 alkalde naman ang naglabas ng kautusan kaugnay ng nasabing mobility restrictions para sa mga hindi bakunado.

## Ordinansa para sa "NO VAX, NO LABAS" policy, lusot na sa Maynila

**I**nilabas na rin ng lokal na pamahalaan ng Maynila ang ordinansa na maghihigpit sa paggalaw ng mga 'di pa bakunadong indibidwal sa lungsod.

Alinsunod na rin ito sa napagkasunduan ng Metro Manila mayors ngayong nasa ilalim pa rin ng Alert level 3 ang National Capital Region, sa gitna ng banta ng omicron variant.

Paliwanag ni Presidential candidate at Manila Mayor Isko Moreno, paraan lamang ito para mapigilan ang mabilis na hawaan ng naturang strain.

"While it is true I agree (with the decision of Metro Manila mayors), we were the first city na nag-bawal sa mall ng mga hindi bakunado. I think that is a message already. In fairness to the mall owners

and operators sumunod sila. Tayo pipilitin natin pero pag talagang nagkaduluhan na eh kailangan may desisyon," ani Moreno.

Giit pa ni Moreno, hindi dapat maging isyu ang pagkakapantay-pantay ng mga residente.

"Wala na tayong masisisi. Kasi napaka-unfair, kasi dapat maging fair din naman tayo. Napaka-unfair sa mga vaccinated, sa mga pum-

ila, sa mga nag-tiyaga para may proteksyon sa kanilang mga sarili. Napaka unfair sa kanila," bwelta niya.

Kaugnay nito, tiniyak ng lokal na pamahalaan na mas paiigtingin pa nila ang vaccine drive sa lungsod para mahimok pa ang mga 'di pa nagpapabakuna.

"We will continue to reach out. Hindi naman po sa pagbubuhay ng bangko, makikita nyo

naman ang mga bakunahan sa Health Center, eskwelahan, shopping malls at drive-thru. Lahat na ng uri ng opsyon, lahat na ng uri ng access, pinipilit naming. Panipis na ng panipis 'yung aming resources pero pinipilit namin habaan ang kamay namin and its time for you to decide," dagdag ng alkalde.

Nanindigan din si Moreno na nakabatay sa siyensya ang mga

aksyon ng pamahalaan.

"Now, 'yung desisyong pipiliin ninyo dalawang bagay po yan: Una, para sa inyo. Pangalawa, para sa pamilya ninyo. Get vaccinated, huwag kayo maniwala sa Marites. Maniwala tayo sa siyensya dahil 1 health problem po ito, threat sa kalusugan natin kaya kailangan nyo proteksyunan ang kalusugan natin," sabi ng opisyal.(GOCAVITE)

## CAVITE POLICE ARRESTED 28 PERSONS AND RECORDED 3,848 MPHS VIOLATORS IN A 24 HOURS POLICE OPS

**C**amp BGen Pantaleon Garcia, Imus City- Cavite Police arrested 28 persons and recorded 3,848 Minimum Public Health Standards (MPHS) protocols in the past 24 hours.

In the campaign against illegal drugs, 15 persons were arrested in a buy-bust operations conducted by Cavite PNP which resulted in the confiscation of 39 pieces of small size heat sealed transparent plastic sachets containing white crystalline substance suspected as shabu, 11 pieces HSTPS containing dried leaves suspected as marijuana and other drug paraphernalia.

Out of eight (8) operations conducted against wanted person, eight individuals were collared for the crime of Child Abuse; for Vi-

olation of Sec. 48 of RA 9003; for Violation of Section 12 Art. II of R.A. 9165 (Indirect Contempt); for Violation of Section 5 of RA 9262; for Violation of R.A. 9165 (Indirect Contempt); for the crime of Slight Physical Injuries in Relation to RA 7610; for the crime of Viol of Art. 316 of the RPC (other forms of swindling); and for the crime of Estafa.

In various cases, five (5) suspects were arrested for Alleged Grave Threat and Attempted Homicide Incident and Shooting Incident transpired in Bacoor City; for Unjust Vexation, Alarm and Scandal and Violation of Provincial Ordinance nr. 166 in Naic; for Selling of Fake Vaccination Card & Certificate of Vaccination/ Violation of RA 1183 (Mandatory Reporting of Notification Diseases Law) in

Dasmariñas City; and for Stabbing incident (Frustrated Homicide) in Silang, Cavite.

A total of 3,848 MPHS violators were recorded, 1,365 for not wearing face mask; 1,954 for improper wearing face mask; 322 violated the curfew hours and 207 violated

the social distancing.

In this time of pandemic, Cavite PNP intensifies its response to health crisis by enforcing IATF MPHS and still sustaining the anti-criminality operations to maintain peace and order in the entire the province. (CAV-PPO/MARGIE BAUTISTA)



Campo said "we will continue to eradicate illegal drugs at all cost. I urge the people of Laguna to actively participate in our campaign against illegal drugs to save their families from the crimes that could be committed by these drug personalities."

## PhilHealth Extends 2021 Accreditation of Healthcare Facilities

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) on Tuesday announced that it will extend the validity of all currently accredited health facilities (HFs) until January 31, 2022.

In its Advisory No. 2021-049 signed by its President and CEO Atty. Dante A. Gierran, the state agency made the extension provided that "... they (HFs) have submitted their complete applications for CY 2022 accreditation to the concerned PhilHealth Regional Office on or before January 31, 2022."

The PhilHealth Chief also reminded that applications received for continuous or renewal of accreditation beyond January 31, 2022 may result in a gap in a facility's accreditation.

Earlier in November 2021, PhilHealth released Advisory 2021-045 saying it has started accepting applications for continuous or renewal of accreditation until December 31, 2021. However, to give HFs ample time and to ensure continuous processing of their claims, the validity was further extended.

Continuous accreditation is provided under the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 10606 or the National Health Insurance Act of 2013. Accreditation is granted to health care providers that have applied through basic participation and complied with the requirements prescribed by PhilHealth, qualifying them to uninterrupted participation in the Program until their accreditation is withdrawn based on rules set by the Corporation. ###
