PhilHealth registration needed prior to face-to-face classes

As more colleges and universities gradually resume face-to-face classes, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) said that registration among students in higher education is now beginning to scale up and that they are closely collaborating with various Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to facilitate the immediate issuance of PhilHealth Identification Number (PIN) to their respective students. This effort is in line with the Commission on Higher Education and Department of Health Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021-001, which sets the guidelines on the gradual reopening of HEIs for limited face-to-face classes during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The said joint circular requires college students attending the limited face-to-face classes to have the necessary health insurance to cover their medical expenses in case they contract COVID-19.

There are two op-

tions by which students can be registered under the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP). For students below 21 years old, they can register as dependents of their biological/foster parents, if not yet registered. This is done by submitting a duly accomplished PhilHealth Member Registration Form (PMRF) together with clear copy of their birth certificate to the nearest PhilHealth office.

Meanwhile, students 21 years old and above shall apply either as Direct or Indirect Contributors under the Program. Students with the capacity to pay the contributions shall be registered as Direct Contributors while those belonging to families with no capacity to pay shall register as Indirect Contributors. Students under this category need to secure a Certificate of Indigency from the Local Social Welfare Office where they reside, which is then submitted to PhilHealth together with their filled-out PMRF. Their contributions for the applicable

year shall be fully subsidized by the Government through the General Appropriations Act.

On the other hand, students who are foreign nationals need to submit acceptable proofs as authorized resident aliens in addition to the PMRF and payment of the prescribed contributions based on PhilHealth Circular No. 2017-0003.

PhiHealth reminds the public that registration is free, nothing that parents and students should be cautious of online fixers and scammers who offer registration assistance for a fee, which it says is unauthorized. The agency also urged colleges and universities to coordinate with its 22 regional offices and branches for possible in-campus registration arrangements.

The State Health Insurer assures Filipino students of immediate eligibility pursuant to the Universal Health Care Law, not only for COVID-19 benefits but for more than 8,000 medical and surgical cases at any accredited healthcare facilities nationwide.###

DILG monitoring five poll hotspots in Cavite

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite - At least five towns and cities in the province of Cavite identified as election hotspots are being monitored by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and security forces of the Philippine National Police (PNP) to suppress any election-related violence that may disrupt the peaceful conduct of the May 9 polls.

In a report of the Cavite News Today, DILG Cavite Provincial Director Lionel Dalope revealed that the cities of Trece Martires and Cavite and the municipalities of Kawit, Rosario, and Amadeo are considered election hotspots in the province.

Dalope clarified that these localities fall under the yellow category, which is a much lighter classification. These areas have at least one election-related incident of intense political rivalry, presence of armed groups, or imminent insurgency threat, according to Dalope.

"Iba-iba ang dahilan upang ma-classify na 'hotspot', kabilang na dito ay ang mga nagdaang karanasan o mga pangyayari sa mga lugar nila na maituturing na nagsasapanganib o kailangan bantayan para maiwasan ang anumang kaguluhan sa panahon ng eleksyon," Dalope explained.

Despite being tagged under the lowest category of election hotspots, these areas are being strictly monitored by the security forces of the PNP to ensure the safety of both the public and the candidates throughout the election period.

Asked about the alleged vote-buying in Silang town, Dalope said

NEDA 4-A: Safe reopening of sectors key to economic revival

The National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) Region 4-A is optimistic that the region will fully recover its losses from the Covid-19 pandemic if it stays consistent with the 10-point policy agenda that promotes the safe reopening of key sectors.

Data from the recently published 2021 Regional Economic Accounts by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) show that the Calabarzon region recorded the fastest economic growth among all regions in the country, posting a 7.6-percent Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP) growth rate and GRDP amounting to P2.73 trillion.

According to NEDA 4-A, the accelerated economic figures reflects a big bounce back from a contraction of 10.5-percent in 2020 and was well above the lower end of the 2021 growth rate target of 5.9-percent.

NEDA 4-A Regional Director Engr. Luis Banua said during the 2021 Report on the Calabarzon Economic

Performance News Conference that the industry and services sectors in the Calabarzon region contributed the largest economic shares in 2021.

Banua reported that the industry sector contributed 51.0-percent share, while the services sector provided 44.1-percent share.

Meanwhile, the remaining 4.8-percent share can be attributed to the continuous activities of the agriculture, forestry, and fishery sectors. Aside from the restricted trade flow for agriculture and fishery products caused by the pandemic, the African Swine Fever (ASF) that devastated the hog-raising industry further pulled the agriculture sector.

NEDA 4-A is hopeful that the agriculture sector will post an accelerated growth this year with the implementation of the Mandanas-Garcia Ruling and the recovery programs launched by the Department of Agriculture.

Banua stressed that local government units would be empowered to assist local farmers and

ernment law enforcement agencies.

Biñan City Mayor Arman Dimaguila who rushed to the scene said the group harassed the residents, his coordinators, leaders and barangay chairmen during a caucus, and a political event before authorities cornered them in Barangay San Vicente on Sunday morning.

Dimaguila, along with Gel Alonte, a vice-mayorality candidate, and congressional candidate Len Alonte said during a press conference on Sunday afternoon that the members of the group are not residents of this city, came from several Batangas towns and believed to be hired by their rival politicians.

He named Mike Yatco, a candidate for Congressman for the Lone District of Biñan

City, and opponent of reelectionist Len Alonte, as the one who allegedly employs these goons.

The said group was seen roaming around the vicinity of the barangay hall of San Vicente. This information reached the city mayor's office which immediately sought the help of the city police. The SWAT team responded to arrest the suspects.

Dimaguila cited that there were three complainants including a policeman, who was a victim of gun-grabbing, and two village chairmen who experienced harassment from the group.

Dimaguila also said that recently, he received information about the arrival of unidentified men, following complaints from his leaders that they were

being harassed by an unidentified five unarmed men who forcibly barged into the house of the political leader. And the 27, all riding in motorcycles, arrived.

Dimaguila added that two of the arrested suspects have a pending record of harassment during the 2019 elections. They were the same men whom Dimaguila said were seen with his opponent during their campaign sorties.

Dimaguila appealed to his rivals not to employ violence and urged them not to resort to harassing the people.

The police said that the suspects could be held liable for usurpation of authority, direct assault, among others.

Yatco is yet to issue his statement in this allegation. **(ROSELLE AQUINO)**

DENR PENRO Cavite conducts installation of 22 units of marker buoys in Ternate Marine Park

In observance of the International Earth Day 2022, DENR PENRO Cavite thru the Coastal and Marine Management Unit (CMMU), together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Ternate, Coast Guard Station Cavite, Coast Guard Auxiliary District NCRCL, and management of Caylabne Bay Resort, tied up for the success of the week-long installation of Marker Buoys within the Core Zone of Ternate Marine Park (TMP).

Eighty-eight (88) volunteers from the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) Auxiliary (102nd, 103rd, 106th, 107th, 108th, 109th, 110th, 125th and 126th squadrons) and volunteer pro-

fessional divers participated in this endeavor highlighting the protection and conservation of marine resources of Cavite Province.

Out of the twenty-five (25) marker buoys targeted for installation, only 20 units were installed due to bad weather conditions and shortage of materials. Meanwhile, the remaining units will be installed once the weather gets better and necessary materials are all in place.

Ternate Municipal Mayor Lamberto Bambao expressed his warm gratitude to DENR PENRO Cavite and partner agencies for extending this kind of project in Ternate. "Ang pangangalaga sa TMP ay hindi

DENR reiterates that posting and pinning of election campaign materials on trees is prohibited under the various legal policies and provisions:

Republic Act No. 3571 "An Act to Prohibit the Cutting, Destroying or Injuring of Planted or Growing Trees, Flowering Plants and Shrubs or Plants of Scenic Value Along Public Roads, in Plazas, School Premises or in Any Other Public Pleasure Ground";

Presidential Decree No. 953 "Requiring

the Planting of Trees in Certain Places and Penalizing Unauthorized Cutting, Destruction, Damaging and Injuring of Certain Trees, Plants and Vegetation"; and
