Barzaga asks colleagues for financial aid for Mabasa heirs



MANILA - Following the reported death

threats and intimidation continuously made against the family of slain veteran broadcaster Percival Mabasa, Cavite 4th District Representative Elpidio Barzaga Jr. on Monday filed a resolution calling on his colleagues to make voluntary contributions in favor of the heirs of Mabasa, who is also

known in the media industry as Percy Lapid.

In filing House Resolution No. 508, Barzaga said members of the House of Representatives, under the leadership of Speaker Martin G. Romualdez, was able to earlier raise PHP5 million in voluntary contributions as reward

Fewer jobless Filipinos 'good sign' of economic recovery: PBBM



MANILA - President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. on Wednesday welcomed the 5 percent drop in the country's unemployment rate, describing it as a "good sign" of economic recovery.

The number of unemployed Filipinos eased to 2.5 million in September this year

from 2.68 million in August, according to data from the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) released Tuesday.

This translates to an unemployment rate of 5 percent, lower than the 5.3 percent unemployment rate in August.

According to PSA, the average unemployment

money for anyone who can provide information that will lead to the arrest of those responsible for the crime.

On account of such reward money, self-confessed gunman, Joel Escorial, surrendered on Oct. 17, 2022 and provided authorities with information on his alleged accomplices in the conspiracy to kill Mabasa. However, Barzaga said that as reported in media accounts, Mabasa's family has also been receiving death threats from unknown persons.

"While the giving of reward is commendable for the immediate ap-

prehension of the perpetrators of the crime, it is also equally important that we provide aid to the heirs of the slain journalist whose relatives are now suffering from threats and intimidation in their lives," he said.

"This representation, taking into consideration of the plight of family members of slain journalists like Percival Mabasa, believes that we must also provide financial assistance to the heirs of the deceased commentator," Barzaga said.

Under HR 508, all donations from House

members will be given to House Secretary General Reginald Velasco not later than Nov. 30, 2022. After the said date, the total amount remitted to the Secretary General shall then be given to the heirs of Mabasa.

By way of seed money and as sponsor of HR 508, Barzaga is giving PHP100,000 as his voluntary contribution for the heirs of Mabasa.

Barzaga's call comes on the same day that cases are set to be filed in connection with the murder of Mabasa, who was shot dead in Las Piñas City last Oct. 3. (PNA)

ment rate this year is already "close to the pre-pandemic level", which was at 5.1 percent in 2019.

"This is a good sign. The economy is trying very hard to grow," Marcos was quoted as saying in a press statement from Malacañang.

He reiterated his commitment to improving the quality of jobs to address underemployment while bolstering job opportunities in the country.

"Ever since we started with the economic team, even before I took office, we really concentrated on the creation of jobs. And that's why it is having the effect now of bringing down our unemployment rate," he added.

Marcos recognized that rising inflation remains a concern under his administration but expressed confidence that the country could sustain the positive momentum with a lower unemployment rate.

"We just have to be able to tolerate the shocks that are coming from abroad. But otherwise, the economy is moving in the right direction," he added.

He also said accelerating job generation remains among the "top priorities" of his administration.

With the decline in unemployment, the PSA said employment rate improved to 95 percent, the highest recorded rate since January 2020.

The significant de-escalation of community quarantine restrictions translated to an employment cre-

ation of 4 million year-on-year, bringing the total employment to 47.6 million in September this year.

Socioeconomic Planning Secretary Arsenio Balisacan earlier said the improved joblessness survey results show "the gains of the full reopening of our economy."

"The government will leverage this momentum by strengthening policy interventions and investing in innovation and technology systems geared toward generating higher quality employment that provides adequate income for Filipino workers and their families," he said. (PNA)

One peso budget for OMB pushed by Senator Jinggoy



A P1 budget for the Optical Media Board (OMB) in next year's P5.286-trillion national budget is suggested by Senator Jinggoy Ejercito Estrada, due to the agency's alleged lackluster performance for the past year.

The senator cited the agency's zero collection, no apprehension of violators, and zero performance in general.

"One year in office, wala talagang ginawa, zero performance. That's why on Monday, during continuing budget plenary deliberations in the Senate, I will propose a one-peso budget for OMB," the lawmaker said.

On October 18, upon learning of the OMB's proposed P75.858-million appropriations for 2023, Estrada questioned its chairman Jeremy Marquez on his agency's alleged boring

performance since he heads the regulatory office to oversee the protection and promotion of intellectual property rights in digital form.

"During your term, there were zero administrative cases filed against violators of RA 9239 from November 2021 when you took over until about July of this year 2022. In contrast, the OMB was averaging 200 administrative cases filed each month before you took over," Estrada said.

Compared with Marquez's predecessors, the OMB collected an amount of P560,000 in 2018; P1.83 million in 2019; P350,000 in 2020; and P2.3 million in 2021 in administrative penalties, Estrada bared.

"And during your term, zero collection and no seizures of counterfeit and illegal storage devices from November 2021 when you took over until August of this year. In fact, you only ordered the OMB agents to conduct seizure operation against violators of RA 9239 just recently for you to have

P62-M FLOOD MITIGATION PROJECT IN NUEVA ECIJA FAST TRACKS BY DPWH



The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) is fast tracking the construction of a flood control structure along Pampana River to protect communities in the municipalities of Nueva Ecija against flooding.

DPWH Secretary Manuel M. Bonoan, citing a report from DPWH Regional Office 3 Director Roseller A. Tolentino, said that currently in the works is a 323.2-linear meter slope protection structure in Barangay Magsalisi in Jaen

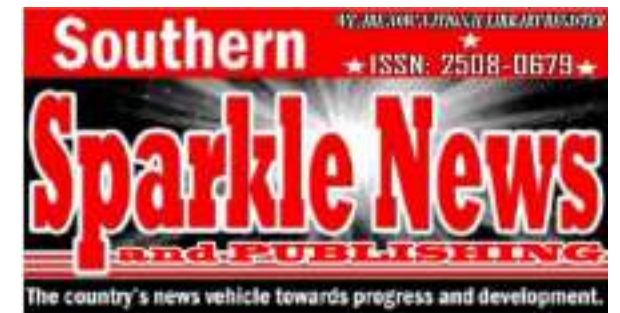
town with a total allocation of P62.3 million the implementation of the flood control project is under the DPWH Nueva Ecija Second District Engineering Office (DEO) headed by District Engineer Elpidio Y Trinidad.

The construction of the flood control project started in April 2022, with an accomplishment rate of 83.04 percent as of October 2022.

Targeted for completion in January 2023, the slope protection structure will safeguard residential areas and ag-

ricultural lands in towns of Jaen, San Isidro, and Sta. Rosa in Nueva Ecija from river water overflow brought by heavy rains during the monsoon and typhoon seasons.

"The flood mitigation structure is expected to prevent riverbank erosion that will improve the waterway in this part of the Pampana River, which is considered as one the major river basins in the country," said Secretary Bonoan. **(Dpwhpio/Renante Arjay Jarobel)**
