of this country and later on, they will exercise their right to vote,” the poll body chief said in a Laging Handa briefing.

Garcia reported that since the resumption of voter registration on Dec. 12, 2022, they have only received over 200,000 voter applications.

“As expected, when

voter's registration starts, the number of registrants is not that high, despite the appeal to young and regular voters to register. We are saddened since our projection is between 1.5 to 2 million new voters,” Garcia said.

Earlier, the poll body reported that from Dec. 12, the re-

sumption of the registration period up to Dec. 30, 2022, new SK voter applicants (aged 15 to 17) reached 60,491.

New registrants for the age bracket of 18 to 30 years old, is at 101,944, while the regular registration applicants (21 years old and above) numbered at 25,694. (PNA)

PANGASINAN TOPS FIREWORKS RELATED INJURIES IN 2022

The Department of Health (DOH) - Ilocos Region today reported a total of 60 fireworks-related injury cases (FWRI) from December 1, 2022 to January 1, 2023.

The figure is 81.82% higher than the number of cases during the same period last year with 33 recorded cases.

Pangasinan tops the list of FWRIs with

45 cases, La Union has 9, Ilocos Sur with 5 and Ilocos Norte with 1 case.

According to the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (RESU) and Health Emergency Management Service (HEMS) FWRI Report, the types of injuries were caused by blast/burn (without amputation - 45.75%, with amputation - 2.3%), eye injury (12.20%) and one stray bullet (1.2%).

There were 49 males and 11 females

involved. Age ranged from 3 to 75 old. A total of 33 cases were actively involved while 27 cases were passive.

Boga and skyrocket (kwitis) are the two major causes of injuries.

Regional Director Paula Paz M. Sydiongco stated that all health emergency personnel and public health facilities have provided emergency treatment to all injured individuals during the yuletide holidays.

Meanwhile, the regional office has awarded cash prizes to winners of the search for the “Pinaka-Bonggang Merry-Making Alternative Sa Paputok” which was launched on December 19, 2022 in Lingayen,

Pangasinan.

The most creative entry was awarded to the Pangasinan Public Employment Service Office 2 with ₱10,000 cash prize followed by Shalom Gideom Balolong who comes in second with ₱8,000 and third place winner, PHO Planning and Training Unit with ₱6,000. A total of ten entries were submitted and non-winners were also given ₱2,000 consolation prizes. (GLEN RAMOS)

DPWH TARGETS CENTRAL LUZON EXPRESSWAY 25-KM OPERATIONAL BY 1ST HALF OF 2023

The expressway project in Central Luzon at the connection of Subic-Clark-Tarlac Expressway (SCTEX)/Tarlac-Pangasinan-La Union Expressway (TPLEX) in Tarlac City, Tarlac is targeted by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) to be operational up to San Juan, Aliaga, Nueva Ecija toward the first half of 2023.

In his report to DPWH Secretary Manuel M. Bonoan, Senior Undersecretary Emil K. Sadain said that the DPWH Unified Project Management Office - Roads Management Cluster 1 (DPWH-UPMO RMC1) is currently working on the completion of additional seven (7) kilometer segment from Guimba-Aliaga Road intersection to San Juan Interchange that will extend to 25 kilometers the already accessible 18-kilometer section of the Central Luzon Link Expressway (CLLEX). The DPWH UPMO RMC 1 team with the contractors and consultants have worked hard to overcome challenges along the way, such as bad weather, right of way issues, difficulty in the transport of construction materials, and Covid-19 impact that caused some delays, added Senior Undersecretary Sadain.



Other than the four (4)-lane two (2)-way expressway with design speed of 100 kilometers per hour, DPWH is also undertaking the construction of three (3) interchanges namely Zaragoza, Aliaga and San Juan that will allow motorists from the secondary and provincial roads to access CLLEX. When fully completed, this 30-kilometer CLLEX Project will facilitate fast, safe, comfortable and reliable means of transport in Central Luzon as it form an important east-west link for the expressway network of Region 3 to ensure a continuous seamless traffic flow for the motoring public from Metro Manila and vice versa passing thru NLEX, SCTEX/TPLEX.

This project is part of the government’s vision of easing traffic congestion and will shorten the usual travel time of 70 minutes between Tarlac City and Cabanatuan City to just 20 minutes.

The project is one of the key infrastructures with funding assistance from the Government of Japan thru Japan International

Cooperation Agency (JICA) and is included in the Luzon Spine Expressway Network projects aimed at reducing travel time from the northernmost part of Luzon, Ilocos, to the southern most part, Bicol, by over 50 percent via the construction of high standard highway network.

In his inspection on December 19, 2022 together with Project Director Benjamin A. Bautista, Senior Undersecretary Sadain has instructed the DPWH UPMO RMC 1 project supervision team of Project Engineers Manuel R. Monfort, Juancho Hernandez, and Albert Manuel and the contractors to put more resources in the project and accelerate their work.

The DPWH-UPMO together with Nueva Ecija First and Second District Engineering Offices are also continuously working on the processing of right of way claims.

Delayed reimbursement or payment of affected property is due to difficulty of right of way claimants to comply with all the documentary
