Marcos assures no rice shortage in coming months

MANILA – President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. on Thursday assured the public that there would be no rice shortage in the country in the coming months.

Marcos gave the assurance following his meeting with officials of the Department of Agriculture (DA) and National Food Authority (NFA) at Malacañan Palace.

He said the country's rice supply situation is in "good shape", as he noted that the government is implementing measures to control the price of rice.

"Hindi tayo magkukulang sa bigas. At tinitingnan natin lahat ng paraan upang ang presyo ay ma-control natin at hindi naman masyadong tataas (We won't have rice short-



age. And we are looking at different ways to control the price so that it wouldn't increase that much),” Marcos said in a video interview.

Under the DA 2023 supply outlook, the country's total supply is

at 16.98 million metric tons (MMT), which is sufficient to cover this year's demand estimated at 15.29 MMT.

Based on this data, the DA said the country would have an ending

SEN. IMEE MARCOS DISTRIBUTE FINANCIAL AID TO CAVITE AICS BENEFICIARIES



A total of 3,000 beneficiaries of the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) program of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) in three municipalities in the province received financial aid from the Office of Senator Imee Marcos yesterday, April 12, 2023.

Personally visiting the towns of Silang, Naic, and Tanza, Senator Imee Marcos distributed financial

aid in the amount of three thousand pesos (Php 3,000) each to beneficiaries of the program such as senior citizens, and Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) who do not receive any stipend or are not beneficiaries of the 4Ps program of the DSWD; members of the Solo Parents sector with which the DSWD program had not been funded; and the marginalized sector such as drivers, fishermen

balance of 1.69 MMT, which is equivalent to 45 days of buffer stock, instead of the 90-day ideal buffer stock to stabilize the price of rice. Marcos, however, pointed out that the NFA should build up its buffer stocks sourced from local farmers for now. He also noted that while the government would still have to consider importation, the volume of rice allowed to enter the country has dropped significantly.

"Magpa-plano kami kung kailangan mag-import, kung kailangan magpahaba, magpamami ng buffer stock sa NFA dahil masyado ng mababa. 'Yun lang ang nakita naming problema, mababa 'yung buffer stock ng NFA. (We are planning when to import, and when to buffer the stocks of NFA because it is very low. That's the only problem that we see, the low NFA buffer stock)," he said.

He said the government will try to prevent the rise in rice prices if

they try to increase the country's rice stockpile. "Kaya't 'yun ang hinahanapan namin ng paraan para i-adjust. Siguro ang magagawa natin ay ang pagbili ay hindi bigla. Hindi malaki. 'Yun lamang. (We're trying to find a way to adjust this. What we could probably do is to buy rice gradually. Not in bulk. That's it). Also, you have to remember. This is agriculture, cyclical ito, by season ito," he said.

The NFA is proposing the importation of 330,000 MT of rice to cover an expected deficit in the country's buffer stock for the relief operations of various agencies in the event of calamities this year.

Agriculture officials said the proposed buffer stock of rice is equivalent to nine days of national consumption from July 2023 onwards and will ensure sufficient volume for calamity and relief requirements from July to December this year.

Given the NFA's budgetary constraints, the agency expects its buffer stocks will decrease to less than 500,000 sacks by July 2023, which is equivalent to less than a day of public consumption.

As of April 6, the Bureau of Plant Industry (BPI) has issued 989 Sanitary and Phytosanitary Import Clearance (SPSIC) applications for 3.170 MMT volume of rice applied out of the 3,024 SPSICs.

Of this volume, 790,449.12 MT of imported rice has arrived.

and farmers who are having difficulty with their livelihood.

During her meeting with members of the media, the lawmaker said that besides collaborating with the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR)-Cavite for the provision of fish nets, fishing equipment, and motorized bancas, the Office of the Senator will also provide five million pesos (Php5M) funds for the KADIWA enhanced grant Agri Tayo program for each LGU to help the farmers and fisherfolks in the development of alternative livelihood such as food processing to better market their products.

Adding to this, the senator said that cold storage would be useful, especially for storing fish catch or even farm produce like onions and other agri products, as well as vehicles such as delivery or reefer van to transport the farm produce to markets outside the province.

Senator Imee Marcos gladly accommodated the questions from the members of the media and even disclosed her insight on the vicious cycle of rice importation happening in the country and suggested the proper analysis using the right data from the government agencies concerned to address the problem of rice farming.

In closing, the senator revealed that she is running for re-election in 2025 and expressed her gratitude for the warm welcome always extended to her by the Caviteños. (MARGIE BAUTISTA)

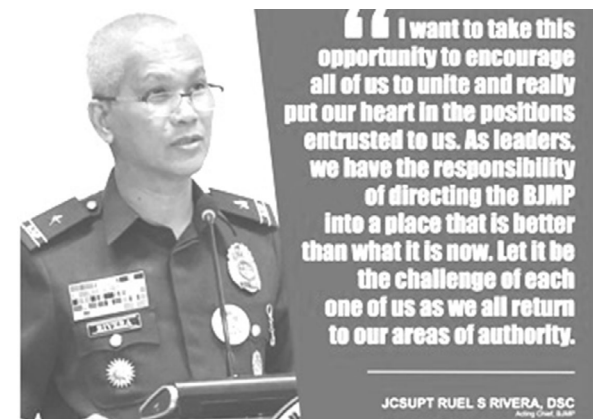

Marcos urged to fight El Niño via upgraded RAIN strategy

Bracing for the return of El Niño, President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. should lead in the upgrading of the RAIN or "Roadmap to Address the Impact of El Niño" so that the weather phenomenon will not seriously harm the country's food, electricity and water supply, House Deputy Speaker Ralph Recto said.

RAIN was a comprehensive strategy paper drafted by NEDA which guided the whole-of-nation's response during

the 2015-2016 El Niño episode.

"Meron ng blueprint saganitong emergency. Kailangan lang ay to dust it off and brush it up, so it will be attuned to the unique characteristics of the 2023 version of El Niño," Recto said.

Recto pointed out that "one big motivating factor" for the President's commission an El Niño response strategy "is that the phenomenon will hit a sector which is under

his jurisdiction – agriculture.

Recto also cited the so-called preexisting comorbidities in agriculture, that include combined fuel-fertilizer crisis, in which the foul weather should be avoided to come in the list.

Water crisis will lead to scarcity in food and will negatively impact livestock and poultry as high temperatures can cause heat stress on animals, Recto warned.

There have been seven severe El Niño events since 1980, with the last one lasting from 2015 to 2016, inflicting \$327 million in agricultural losses, according to PAGASA.

The Aquino administration crafted RAIN, which focused on ensuring food security, health, energy security, safety on 67 impacted provinces and Metro Manila in an effort to address the 2015-2016 El Niño episode. **(BENJIE J. MURILLO)**
