PGC Empowers Farmers and Fisherfolks through Hito Fingerlings Distribution

step toward improving their income and livelihood opportunities.

Monte of the Regional Information and Communication Technology Management Division 4A, Col Joseph Adelbert A. The newly built house is fully equipped with complete electrical and water lines, a tiled bathroom, a fully functional kitchen, and other essential living spaces, making it ready for immediate occupancy. 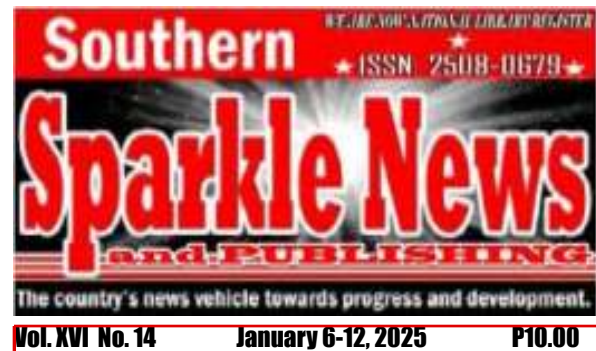

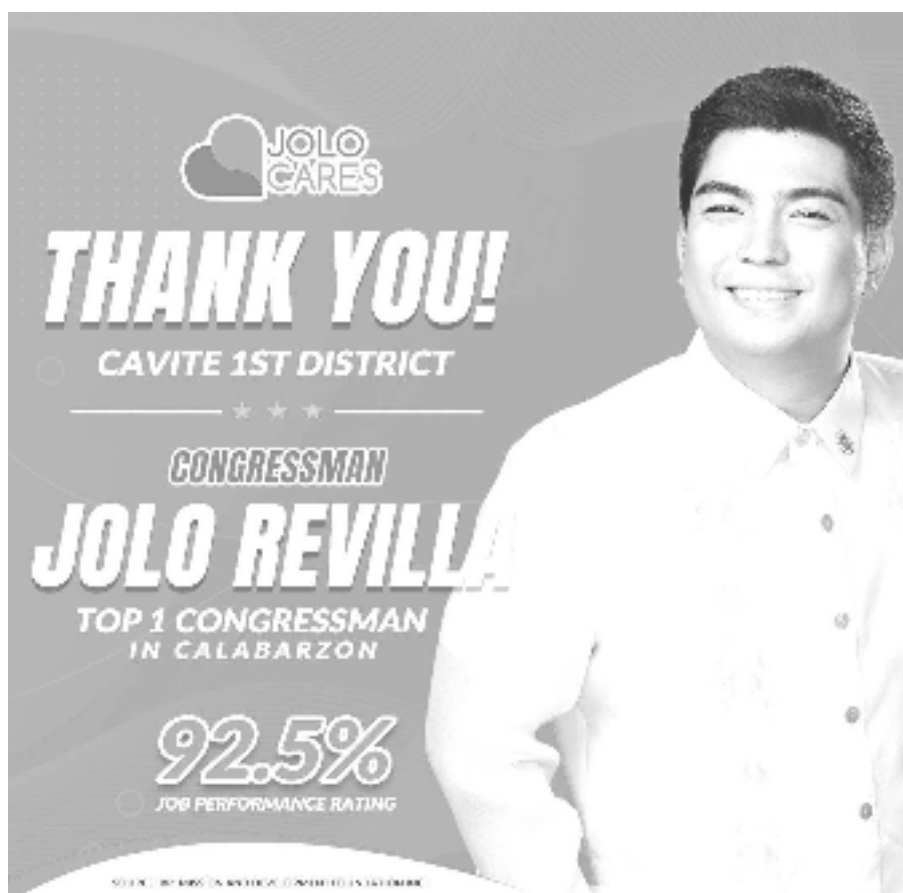
