

AGU-IO CITY— The Commission on Human Rights (CHR) Region 3 took center stage during the 5th anniversary

of the Prime Alliance of Publishers, Editors, and Reporters (PA-PER) and the 5th Na-

tional Press Congress, held on December 7 at Hotel Enrico Kisad. "Empowering the Voices That Shape Our Nation," gathered media practitioners from across the Philippines to discuss pressing issues in journalism. CHR Region 3, led by Regional Director Atty. Leorae D. Valmonte, delivered a vital session that underscored the importance of protecting the rights of media professionals in an evolving media landscape.

Atty. Hannah Jezel I. Rosario, a lecturer from CHR Region 3, captivated the audience with an insightful discussion on the rights of media practitioners, both as individuals and as professionals. She tackled the complexities of cyber libel under the Cybercrime Prevention Act of 2012, providing practical guidance to ensure ethical and responsible reporting.
