housing rooftops and translates that progress into direct, sustained support for the host community.

Implemented in partnership with Extraordinary Enclaves and the Joy~Nostalg Foundation, the initiative reinforces SOLARIS' commitment to ensuring that clean energy development creates shared value where it is built.

The Community Assurance Support under NING\*NING is a contract-anchored package of community benefits provided annually in exchange for rooftop use, enabled through a long-term usufruct agreement. It includes enhanced safety and security measures, along with other community improvements, ensuring that while solar power feeds the grid, tangible and lasting value flows back to homeowners and the community. This ceremony marks the first turnover under the 50-year term.

The turnover builds on the project's growing national prominence following President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.'s visit to the site recently, which highlighted NING\*NING as a model for advancing renewable energy alongside inclusive community development. Community leaders and representatives from key government agencies, including the Department of Energy (DOE), Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD), and Pag-IBIG Fund, were present to formally document and reaffirm Community Assurance Support commitments, underscoring the proj-

ect's multi-stakeholder foundation linking housing, clean energy transition, and homeowner welfare.

"This is our way of appreciation and of showing that we are serious," said Jacinto Ng, Jr., Group Executive Officer of Joy~Nostalg Group. "This fulfills promises beyond contractual obligation. Our goal is not just returns, but bettering lives -here in the community, across the country, and ultimately for the world."

For 2025, the Community Assurance Support projects address priority needs identified with the community, covering:

- Security - including motorcycle patrols, radios, CCTV systems, and other safety enhancements.

- Health and Education - including daycare improvements, school supplies, and health center upgrades.

- Community and Leisure - including clubhouse enhancements, play areas, and programs that strengthen community life.

A representative of the Pasinaya Homes Prime Central Homeowners Association welcomed the turnover, calling it 'a clear and concrete set of commitments', and reaffirmed the HOA's readiness to work with Solaris and its partners to sustain programs so families benefit long-term.

## Cavite holds 4th quarter joint CPPOC, PADAC, PTF-ELCAC council meeting;,,

**T**he Cavite Provincial Peace and Order

Council (CPPOC), Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC), and Provincial Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict (PTF-ELCAC) convened their 4th Quarter Joint Meeting on December 17 at The Bayleaf Hotel in the City of General Trias, reaffirming the province's unified approach to maintaining peace, order, and community security.

Governor Francisco Gabriel "Abeng" Remulla formally called the meeting to order. Afterwards, he led the signing of the PTF-ELCAC's pledge of recommitment to sustain Cavite's Stable Internal Peace and Security together with members of the council.

The Provincial Government of Cavite recognized outstanding local government units (LGUs) and barangay peacekeeping personnel for exemplary performance in barangay justice, peacekeeping, and anti-drug initiatives.

For the 2025 Lupong Tagapamayapa Incentives Award - Component City Category, the provincial award was conferred on Barangay Maharlika, City of Imus.

The CY 2025 Trailblazers for Outstanding Performance of Barangay Tanods (TOP Barangay Tanod) award was also given to Barangay Maharlika, City of Imus, with Barangay Tanod Joey Garba receiving individual recognition for exemplary service in community peacekeeping.

The councils also took note of the CY 2024 Peace and Order Council (POC) and Anti-Drug Abuse Council (ADAC) Performance Audit, reflecting the collective efforts of LGUs in strengthening local governance mechanisms against criminality and illegal drugs. stipulated in the Peace and Order and Public Safety (POPS) Plan.

Major General Ronald Jess Alcudia, Commander of the Reserve Command of the Philippine Army, delivered a directional message urging all stakeholders to remain vigilant, proactive, and closely coordinated to sustain the province's gains in peace, order, and security.

DILG-Cavite OIC Provincial Director Marcial Juangco also conveyed the agency's message of support, emphasizing the importance of sustaining peace and order and strengthening coordinated efforts toward ensuring drug-free communities.

Meanwhile, Lieutenant Colonel Rommel S. Panganiban, Executive Officer of Task Force Ugnay, presented situational updates on the Status of the Internal Peace and Security Plan (SIPS) in Cavite. Updates from other member agencies were likewise presented, reflecting their strong commitment to the implementation of programs aimed at maintaining peace, order, and security in the province.

The joint meeting underscored the Provincial Government of Cavite's continued commitment to an integrated, whole-of-government approach in promoting peace, countering illegal drugs, and safeguarding communities through strong collaboration among LGUs, law enforcement agencies, national government partners, and other stakeholders.--- OPIO



## CARD Bank opens 2nd Islamic banking branch in Marawi City

To meet livelihood needs, the branch provides Shari'ah-compliant financing products, including Murabahah, Mudarabah, and Musharakah for Micro-Agri and Micro-Enterprise, as well

as Murabahah 2 for Supplemental Commodity Financing. Ijarah is also offered for motorcycle and vehicle leasing. All products are designed to support clients' livelihoods without conflicting with their religious beliefs.

Underscoring the significance of this expansion, Bangsamoro Board of Investments Chairman (BBOI) Mohamad Omar Pasigan emphasized, "The opening of the second Shari'ah-compliant branch in BARMM is clear proof that there is space for services that truly respond to the needs of the Muslim

community. It creates greater opportunities for families and entrepreneurs in the region."

Expanding financial inclusion in Muslim communities

CARD Bank's move into Islamic banking responds to the call of Muslim communities for financial services that reflect their faith. In BARMM, many families remain unbanked due to the lack of culturally and religiously aligned services.

Through Shari'ah-compliant banking, women, small entrepreneurs, and Muslim households gain equal access to safe, fair, and affordable financial services. It is a crucial step toward more resilient and sustainable livelihoods in the region.

To ensure the proper and sensitive implementation of Islamic banking, CARD Bank collaborated with Islamic finance and Shari'ah advisory experts.
