

BACOOR CITY AND DPWH COLLABORATE ON CRUCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS





PGC hosts Data Privacy Act Seminar to strengthen information security



The Provincial Government of Cavite (PGC) successfully conducted a seminar entitled "Promoting Data Privacy Compliance and Accountability under the Data Privacy Act of 2012: An Awareness Seminar for Department Heads and Medical Practitioners in the Provincial Government of Cavite" at the Function Hall of the New Provincial Government Center, Trece Martires City on February 18. The activity emphasized the importance of safeguarding personal and institutional data within government offices.

The seminar was spearheaded by the Provincial Information and Communications Technology Office (PICTO), led by Ms. Annie Q. Tazon, Officer-in-Charge

and PGC Data Protection Officer.

Engr. Gilbert V. Gandia, Provincial Administrator and Head of the PGC Data Breach Response Team, delivered the opening remarks, setting the tone for an informative and engaging session and highlighting the importance of compliance with data privacy regulations.

Mr. Cleo R. Martinez, IT Officer II of the National Privacy Commission, served as the resource speaker. He provided participants with in-depth discussions on the key provisions of the Data Privacy Act of 2012, practical strategies for data protection, and best practices in handling sensitive personal information in government operations.

The seminar was attended by department

heads and designated representatives from various offices of the Provincial Government of Cavite, who actively participated in the discussions. The activity ensured that key officials and personnel are well-equipped to comply with data privacy standards and uphold public trust.

The program concluded with closing remarks from Atty. Annaliza Mercene-Pulmones, Provincial Legal Officer and PGC Compliance Officer for Privacy, who reinforced the vital role of public servants in maintaining data confidentiality, integrity, and accountability.

The meeting strengthened coordination between the Bacoor LGU and DPWH, reaffirming their shared commitment to the timely and efficient completion of these vital projects.

PPOC Meeting

Government leaders and security stakeholders convened at the New Cavite Government Center, Trece Martires City on February 19 for the first quarter joint meeting of the Cavite Provincial Peace and Order Council, Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council, and Provincial Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict, underscoring a unified push to strengthen peace and public safety across the province.

Governor Francisco Gabriel D. Remulla presided over the session, which highlighted interagency coordination, legislative support, and community-based strategies to address criminality, illegal drugs, insurgency, and other security concerns.

Among the key agenda items was the presentation of the CY 2025 Peace and Order and Public Safety (POPS) Plan accomplishment report,

covering physical and financial gains from the first to fourth quarters. Updates were also delivered by law enforcement and anti-drug units on crime trends, barangay drug-clearing operations, and ongoing campaigns against illegal narcotics.

The 202nd Infantry Brigade of the Philippine Army provided a security briefing on anti-insurgency efforts, while social welfare officials reported on programs supporting former rebels under the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program (ECLIP).

Fire safety and disaster readiness were likewise tackled, with the Bureau of Fire Protection presenting measures to strengthen emergency response and public safety compliance.

The council also heard updates from civil society partners and the joint secretariat, reflecting a whole-of-government and whole-of-society

approach to peace-building.

In the afternoon session, members deliberated on proposed resolutions, including the declaration of certain individuals involved in New People's Army "tour of duty" activities as persona non grata in the province, the inclusion of the National Police Commission in the Provincial Peace and Order Council, and the creation of a special action committee for the protection and inclusion of refugees, asylum seekers, and stateless persons.

Officials emphasized that harmonized policies, intelligence sharing, and grassroots engagement remain critical in addressing evolving security challenges. The joint council reaffirmed its commitment to sustained collaboration among government agencies, local government units, and community stakeholders to ensure a safer and more resilient Cavite.--- OPIO

(Small Enterprise Acceleration Lab – Business Education and Growth Initiative for Nano-entrepreneurs) program officially kicked off on February 10, 2026, at Gawaran Hall, 3rd Floor, Bacoor City Hall, bringing together 30 nano-entrepreneurs for an intensive four-day entrepreneurial development initiative designed to strengthen small businesses across

Cavite. The program is a collaborative effort among the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) - Cavite Provincial Office, Philippine Trade Training Center - Global MSME Academy (PTTC-GMEA), BPI Foundation, Inc., BPI BanKo, and the Bacoor City Local Government Unit. Cocaine seized in Calamba buy-bust; 2 Indian nationals arrested

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna - Two Indian nationals were arrested in a buy-bust operation conducted by the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) in Villa de Calamba, Barangay

La Mesa, early morning of February 21, 2026. The operation was carried out at around 2:30 a.m. at Lot 3, Block 95, Villa de Calamba, led by the PDEA RO-NCR Southern District Office in coordination with the PDEA RO-4A Laguna

Provincial Office, PDEA RO-4A Regional Special Enforcement Team (RSET), and the Calamba Philippine National Police (PNP). Seized during the operation were approximately 44,000 grams (44 kilograms)

of suspected cocaine with a standard value of ₱233,200,000 and an estimated street value of ₱176,000,000. Confiscated drug evidence included two pieces weighing approximately 1,000 grams each of sus-

pected to be cocaine, wrapped in transparent plastic and placed inside a brown paper bag, and forty-two pieces weighing approximately 1,000 grams each of suspected cocaine, wrapped in transparent plastic food wrap and placed inside

an open carton box. Authorities also recovered non-drug evidence, including one genuine ₱500 bill placed on top of sixteen bundles of boodle money used as buy-bust money, one brown pa-

PNFPWD National Summit advances unified action for disability-inclusive development



A powerful convergence of advocates, trailblazers, and changemakers took place during the Philippine National Federations of Persons with Disabilities (PNFPWD) National General Assembly and Summit from February 24-27 at One Tagaytay Place Hotel Suites, Tagaytay City.

The five-day gathering united the nation's strongest voices in the disability sector—leaders and champions committed to shaping a more inclusive and accessible future for all Filipinos. Anchored on solidarity and shared purpose, the summit became a dynamic platform for collaboration, policy discussion, and empowerment.
