# PhilHealth's YAKAP a 'game changer' in PH healthcare

**W**ith benefits covering laboratory, outpatient consultation and access to free medicine, the Philhealth Yaman ng Kalusugan Program (YAKAP), which expanded primary care benefit packages, is seen to become a 'game changer' in the country's implementation of the Universal Healthcare (UHC) framework.

In an interview with the Philippine Information Agency and Radyo Pilipinas Lucena's Sulong Southern Tagalog radio program, Arturo Ardiente, Field Operations Division chief for PhilHealth CALABARZON, noted that YAKAP will encourage more Filipinos to seek not only medical treatments but also preventive care.

"Sa ating kultura, kapag tayo ay nagkakasakit ay doon pa lang tayo nagpapa-check-up.



In fact, ito 'yung challenge natin sa YAKAP. Binabago natin 'yung mindset ng tao na hindi lang kung kailan malala na 'yung pagkakasakit ay saka ka tatakbo sa ospital."

As part of the UHC, the PhilHealth YAKAP

expands the benefits provided by the Konsulta program.

"Medyo limitado 'yung kakayanan ng Konsulta na matugunan 'yung mga pangangalagang pangkalusugan, pang-primary 'yung preventive care ng ating mga

mamamayan."

Ardiente underscored that members do not need to be hospitalized to avail of their YAKAP benefits.

"YAKAP 'yung preventive approach natin [dahil] hindi na kailangang ma-ospital para

ma-avail 'yung benefits. This is our preventive approach at hindi kailangang may sakit ka para ma-avail 'yung benefits."

Aside from room and professional fees, patients also normally need to pay for their

own medicines even when receiving inpatient care. But with YAKAP, patients can access up to 54 free medicines in accredited facilities nationwide.

"We want to ensure na kapag dumating 'yung pagkakasakit, ay hindi malugso ang kabuhayan. Sinisiguro ng UHC Law na hindi magiging dahilan ang karamdaman para maghirap ang mga Filipino."

PhilHealth YAKAP covers a wide range of medicines from over-the-counter drugs such as paracetamol to antibiotics and maintenance drugs.

"Makukuha mo ito nang libre at ang bawat kababayan natin ay mayroong allotment na P20,000 per year. Pero para ma-avail mo ito ay dapat YAKAP physician ang mag-prescribe nito sa iyo." (PB-PIA CALABARZON)

# Bacoor City pays tribute to solo parents

# Expanded 4PH opens new homes in Naic, Cavite



**N**AIC, Cavite — The Expanded Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino (4PH) Program in Cavite is in full swing as construction of the Naic View Residences Phase 2 and Glori Mor Ville Phase 2 starts.

Last May 6, Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DH-SUD) Undersecretary Ramon Nicholo Molina and National Housing Authority (NHA) Assistant General Manager Alvin Feliciano led the groundbreaking of the two housing projects.

Once completed, Naic View Residents Phase 2 and Glori Mor

Phase 2 will provide a total of 590 housing units under the Expanded 4PH for families affected by the Manila Bay Mandamus Program and other government infrastructure projects.

The project includes 336 housing units in Naic View Residences Phase 2 and 254 housing units in Glori Mor Ville Phase 2.

In a statement, the NHA noted that the housing projects are expected to provide high-quality and affordable homes to Caviteño families.

"Ang itatayong gusali ay inaasahang makatulong sa pamilyang Caviteño para sa ganap na pagsasakatuparan ng

kanilang pangarap na abot-kaya at de-kalidad na pabahay, na isa sa mga layunin ng Expanded Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino Housing ng pamahalaan."

Following the groundbreaking ceremony, key housing agencies also led the awarding of land titles to qualified NHA beneficiaries who were affected by the Supreme Court Mandamus Program to Clean Up the Manila Bay, among other government infrastructure projects. ## 'Bawat Barangay Makikinabang' program enables development of barangays in Cavite

**G**ENERAL TRIAS CITY, Cavite — President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. reaffirmed the national government's commitment to strengthening community development, emphasizing the importance of empowering barangays as frontliners in delivering vital services to the people.

During his visit in General Trias City in Cavite on Monday, May 4, he underscored that the sustained support from the national government for local government units, particularly at the barangay level, remains a priority of his administration to ensure improved public services and expanded opportunities for Filipinos.

"Ang ginawa po namin ay lahat ng probinsya, lahat ng lungsod, lahat ng mga bayan kukuha po tayo dun sa pondong 'yan [Local Government Support Fund] at ipinamimigay natin sa ating mga local

government officials. Kasama doon sa programang 'yun. Siyempre 'yung pondo ibinababaw natin sa local government officials," the Chief Executive said.

Barangay leaders in General Trias, Cavite, have committed to implementing well-coordinated and responsive programs, ensuring that national government support translates into concrete and inclusive development at the grassroots level.

General Trias City Liga ng mga Barangay President Ramil Barrientos said barangays commit to implement priority projects based on their respective needs, including the installation of solar lighting and the provision of patrol motorcycles.

"Maglalagay kami ng solar lamp at ilaw sa mga lugar sa aming barangay, habang ang ibang naman ay nagkaroon ng patrol motorcycles para magamit sa pagpapatupad ng peace and order," Barrientos said.

He noted that these

initiatives aim to improve public order and safety and encourage economic activity at the community level.

"Kasi alam namin na 'pag tahimik ang lugar, 'pag tahimik at maliwanag 'yung ating barangay, marami tayong mahihikayat na manira-

han at mamumuhunan," he added.

Barrientos also expressed gratitude to President Marcos Jr. for extending support to local communities, particularly through education-focused programs.

"Sa ngalan ng Liga ng mga Barangay, kami

po ay nagpapasalamat sa ating Pangulo sa lahat ng suportang ibinibigay niya sa aming lungsod. Umasa ang ating Pangulo na susuporta kami sa lahat ng adhikain ng pamahalaan," he said.

With continued backing from the national government, ba-

barangay leaders in Cavite remain optimistic that these initiatives will further strengthen local governance, improve public safety, and create more opportunities for communities across the province.

### Mula kusina hanggang kamera

**M**ula sa simpleng pagtitinda ng lutong-bahay sa harap ng kanilang tahanan hanggang sa pag-aayos ng mga putahe para sa isang pelikula. Ganito ang naging paglalakbay ni Procy B. Balasoto, 53, mula Sta. Cruz, Laguna. Noon, ang pagluluto ay paraan lamang para kumita. Ngayon, ito na ang nagbukas ng mga oportunidad na hindi niya inakalang mararating niya.

#### Unang pagkakataon

Bilang isang nag-iisang magulang ng tatlong anak, hirap si Procy na makahanap ng tuloy-tuloy na pagkakakitaan. Noong 2013, naging kliyente siya ng CARD MRI Rizal Bank, Inc., isang microfinance-oriented rural bank sa ilalim ng CARD MRI. Sa tulong ng mga natutuhan niya sa center meeting at ng kaniyang unang loan, nagsimula siya ng maliit na negosyo ng uling at bigas.

Kasabay nito, unti-unti niyang binuhay ang hilig sa pagluluto. Gumagawa siya ng mga lutong-bahay at inilalako ang mga ito sa mga kapitbahay at dumaraan. Para madagdagan ang kita, naging reseller din siya ng personal care products.

Hindi doon natapos ang kanyang pagsisikap. Dumalo siya sa iba't ibang livelihood seminars kung saan natuto siyang gumawa ng mga produktong maaari niyang ibenta. Tuwing lingguhang center meeting, nagdadala siya ng mga niluto at iniaalok sa kapwa kliyente at sa kanilang Account Officer. Dahil sa sarap ng kaniyang luto, patuloy siyang sinuportahan ng mga ito. Pagkatapos ng meeting, nagpapatuloy pa siya sa paglalako ng kaniyang mga paninda.

Para kay Procy, ayos lang ang ganitong routine. Hangga't may naluluto siya at naibebenta ang kaniyang produkto para sa pangangailangan ng pamilya, sulit ang lahat ng pagod.

#### Mas malaking oportunidad

Noong 2023, nagkaroon siya ng bagong pagkakataon nang mag-alok ang CARD MRI Hijos Tours ng culinary scholarship para sa microfinance clients. Dahil kilala ang kanyang galing sa pagluluto sa kanilang lugar, siya ay inirekomenda ng kanilang Account Officer. Agad niya itong tinanggap at natapos ang kaniyang culinary studies sa loob ng taon ding iyon.

Dito nagsimulang magbukas ang mas marami pang oportunidad. Naging bahagi siya ng paghahanda ng pagkain para sa mga kalahok ng Hijos Tours sa iba't ibang aktibidad at tours. Sa tulong ng isang chef specialist, nakatulong siya sa pagbuo ng menu para sa Kasadya Fine Dining at naging food stylist din para sa food tours. Natutuhan niya hindi lang ang pagluluto kundi pati ang pagpakita ng mga pagkaing Pilipino sa paraang mas kaakit-akit at makabuluhan.

Bukod sa skills, nakahanap din siya ng komunidad. Sa kaniyang pagsali bilang cook, nakilala niya ang iba't ibang tao. Nakatulong ito upang mas tumaas ang kaniyang kumpiyansa sa sarili at mas mahasa ang kaniyang pakikisalamuha. Mas lalo rin niyang minahal ang iba't ibang kultura sa Pilipinas.

Pagsapit ng sumunod na taon, naging head chef partner siya ng Hijos Tours sa Laguna. Sa kaniyang bagong ginagampanan, natuto siya ng iba't ibang heritage recipes mula sa iba't ibang rehiyon ng bansa. Isa sa mga hindi niya malilimutang karanasan ay ang paghahanda ng pagkain para sa mahigit isang daang tao sa isang event. Sa kaniyang mga biyahe, hindi lang kaalaman sa pagluluto ang kaniyang nakukuha kundi pati aral sa pagiging simple at matatag sa buhay.

Sa kabila ng kaniyang trabaho, nananatiling prayoridad ni Procy ang kaniyang mga anak. Sinisiguro niyang nabibigyan niya ng oras at gabay ang mga ito sa kanilang pag-aaral at personal na pinagdaraan.

#### Mula kusina patungong kamera

Ngayong taon, dumating ang isa na namang hindi inaasahang oportunidad. Matapos ang isang event ng Hijos Tours, napili si Procy bilang assistant food stylist para sa pelikula ng BENTE Productions, isang multimedia company sa ilalim ng CARD MRI. Tampok sa pelikula ang kuwento ng isang kusinerang bulag, kung kaya't mahalaga ang papel ng pagkain sa produksyon ng pelikula.

Hindi man niya ito inaasahan, buong puso niya itong tinanggap. Maingat niyang inihanda at inayos ang bawat putahe para sa pelikula.

Aminado siya na hindi niya naisip na darating ang ganitong pagkakataon. Aniya, "Ang laki po ng tuwa, sobrang galak na galak, kasi siyempre, bilang simpleng nanay, hindi ko akalain na aabot sa ganito ang kakayahan ko at yung niluluto ko. Hindi kayang presyohan ang saya."

#### Luto ng pangarap

Sa ngayon, plano ni Procy na ipagpatuloy ang kaniyang pagluluto upang maipakilala ang kulturang Pilipino. Patuloy niyang pinahuhusay ang kaniyang kakayahan at nais niyang makapaglingkod sa iba sa pamamagitan ng kaniyang talento.

Para sa kapwa niyang kusinera, ito ang kanyang payo: "Huwag matakot sumubok at tuklasin ang mga bagong bagay at potensyal." Para sa kaniya, ang pagluluto ay hindi lang basta pagsunod sa resipe. Ito ay pagkamalikhain, patuloy na pagkatuto, at paghahanap ng ganda kahit sa simpleng putahe.

Mula sa pagtitinda ng pagkain sa harap ng kanilang bahay, hindi inakala ni Procy na darating ang araw na ang kanyang mga luto ay mapapanood na sa pelikula. Ipinakikita ng kaniyang kuwento na sa sipag, tiyaga, at suporta ng komunidad, ang simpleng simula ay maaaring humantong sa mas malalaking oportunidad.

saryo on Friday, May 22.

SSS President and Chief Executive Officer Robert Joseph M. de Claro said the agency continues to strengthen frontline services, simplify processes, and modernize systems to better respond to member concerns, in line with the shared goal of improving government service delivery for Filipinos.

"As one of the country's largest public service institutions, SSS recognizes that every transaction affects the daily lives of our members. We continue to improve our systems, processes, and frontline services because faster and more responsive government service is not only an operational goal, but a public responsibility," de Claro said.

"The agency's strong financial performance in 2025 has strengthened its capacity to expand member assistance programs and accelerate reforms aimed at improving service delivery," de Claro added.

In 2025, SSS posted a net income of P142.97 Billion while its Reserve Fund surpassed the P1 Trillion mark for the first time in the institution's history, a major milestone that further strengthens the long-term stability of the pension fund for current and future members.

"Our strong financial position allows us to invest directly in better services, new technologies, infrastructure upgrades, and programs that will improve the experience of our members," de Claro said.

He also highlighted the agency's expanded relief programs designed to help Filipino workers and families cope with the continuing impact of the national energy emergency.

As part of these efforts, de Claro said SSS is also preparing to roll out an Energy Sustainability Loan Program in September.

The program allows qualified SSS members with a Mandatory Provident Fund account to avail themselves of financing to install residential solar panel systems, payable for up to seven years. The Mandatory Provident Fund Program is a compulsory retirement savings scheme that automatically enrolls SSS members who are contributing to the regular SSS program with a Monthly Salary Credit (MSC) above P20,000.

SSS aims to support at least 100,000 homes by 2028 through the program, which seeks to help families manage rising electricity costs while promoting long-term energy sustainability.

According to de Claro, the initiative reflects the evolving role of SSS in responding not only to traditional social security concerns, but also to emerging economic pressures affecting Filipino households.

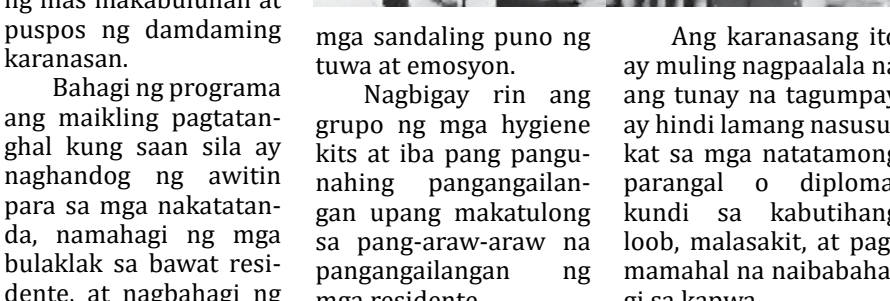

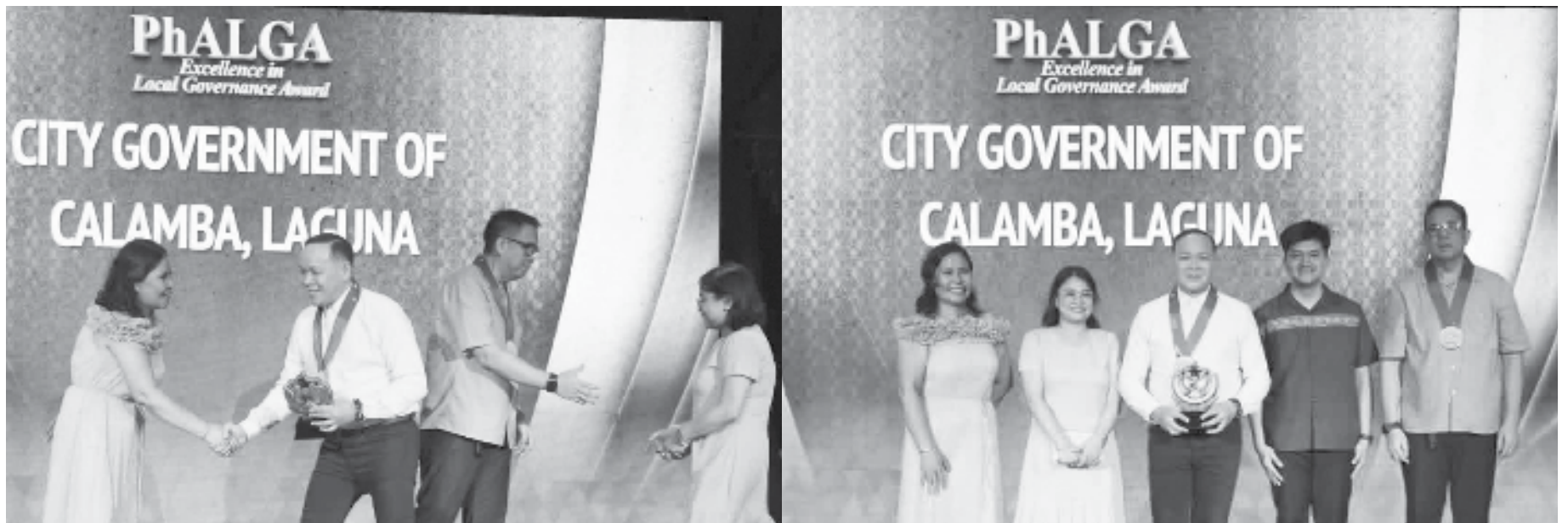
