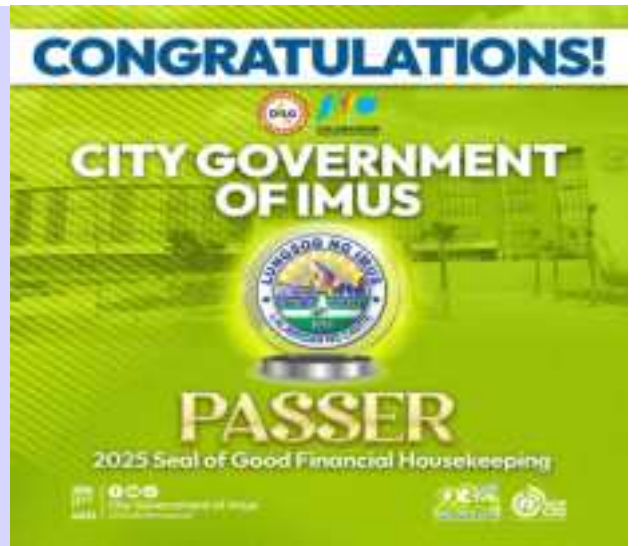

128th Philippine Independence Day Celebration at Aguinaldo Shrine

Cavite Service Caravan reaches Indang for third leg, strengthens delivery of essential services

The Provincial Government of Cavite continues its commitment to bringing accessible and responsive public service closer to communities as the Cavite Service Caravan rolled out its third leg in the Municipality of Indang on May 21, 2026.

Led by Governor Abeng Remulla, the service caravan further reinforced the provincial government's dedication to inclusive and people-centered governance through the delivery of various front-line services directly to Caviteños.

The one-stop caravan gathered provincial offices, national government agencies, and partner organizations to provide a comprehensive range of programs and assistance aimed at addressing the immediate needs of residents, particularly those with limited access to government services.

Among the key



services offered were free medical consultations, dental and oral health care, laboratory services such as ECG and fasting blood sugar tests, pharmacy assistance, and fluoride varnish application for children. Emergency medical support was also made available to ensure prompt response to health-related concerns.

Employment and livelihood opportu-

nities were likewise highlighted through job matching activities, career coaching sessions, and assistance from agencies such as PhilHealth, TESDA, BIR, PSA, DTI, and Landbank of the Philippines. Entrepreneurship support, cooperative assistance, and the promotion of local products through a trade fair also formed part of the caravan.

Agricultural support services, includ-

ing the distribution of vegetable seeds and seedlings, educational materials, and technical assistance for farmers and fisherfolk, were also extended during the activity.

Meanwhile, social welfare assistance, family planning counseling,

legal aid services, and specialized support for persons with disabilities were made accessible to residents. Veterinary services such as anti-rabies vaccination, deworming, and free consultations for pets were likewise provided.

Digital literacy pro-

grams, internet connectivity services, and information dissemination booths further promoted awareness and accessibility of government programs among participants.

Joining Governor Remulla during the third leg of the caravan were Vice Governor Ram Revilla Bautista, Congressman Ping Remulla, and 7th District Board Member Aldrin Anacan. They were warmly welcomed by the local officials of Indang headed by Mayor Vergel Fidel.

As the Cavite Service Caravan continues its province-wide rollout, the Provincial Government of Cavite remains steadfast in its mission to make government services more accessible, efficient, and responsive to the needs of every Caviteño.--- OPIO

UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE EXPANSION DRIVES HIGHER PHILHEALTH SUPPORT; HIGHLIGHTS NEED FOR LONG-TERM SUSTAINABILITY



MANILA—Health policy experts, development partners, and healthcare leaders underscored the need for sustainable financing, institutional resilience, and long-term policy commitment to secure the future of Universal Health Care (UHC) in the Philippines during a Health Forum held at the Healthware Cancer Care Hospital on June 11. Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth), the Philippine Institute for Development Studies (PIDS), and the Private

Sector Advisory Council (PSAC) to examine the progress of UHC implementation and the challenges that must be addressed to ensure its continued success. Participants noted that the UHC Law has significantly expanded healthcare access for millions of Filipinos, strengthening financial protection and bringing essential health services closer to communities. However, speakers emphasized that sustaining these gains will require responsive financing mechanisms, prudent fiscal management, and continued investments in healthcare infra-

structure and workforce development. Dr. Edwin M. Mercado, President of PhilHealth, highlighted hallmark reforms and improved service delivery as mandated by the UHC Law. He stressed that healthcare investments should be viewed not merely as expenditures but as investments in national development. "This irreversible shift in our baseline of support UHC Law - immediate eligibility from the and expanded benefit packages. Now our strategies must shift towards smarter spending through tailor-fit interventions to maximize the value of every peso spent for Filipinos." Meanwhile, Dr. Valerie

Gilbert Ulep of PIDS emphasized the importance of ensuring that healthcare expansion is supported by sound fiscal planning and evidence-based policymaking. He noted that maintaining public trust in the healthcare system depends on balancing broader access with long-term financial sustainability. PSAC Health Sector Lead and Ayala Corporation Chief Social Infrastructure Officer, Paolo Borromeo, highlighted the importance of sustained public-private collaboration, innovative approaches to healthcare financing, and institutional partnerships in supporting Universal Health Care.

"Universal Health Care is a shared commitment that extends beyond any single institution. Sustaining the momentum we have started requires strong partnerships across government, healthcare providers, industry, and the private sector. As healthcare needs continue to evolve, our collective challenge is not only to expand access, but also to build resilient and sustainable systems that can continue serving future generations of Filipinos," Borromeo said. Throughout the discussion, speakers agreed that healthcare is both a social imperative and an economic investment. A healthier population contributes to a

more productive workforce, stronger communities, and greater national competitiveness. The session also explored the role of government, healthcare providers, and development institutions in building a resilient healthcare system capable of meeting the evolving needs of Filipinos while remaining financially sustainable. The health forum forms part of broader efforts to foster informed dialogue on the future of healthcare financing and delivery in the Philippines, reinforcing the shared commitment to achieving better health outcomes for every Filipino. 491 residents benefit from Medical and Dental Mission in Carmona

A total of 491 residents of Brgy. Para sa maraming dumalong kliyente, malaking tulong ang ganitong uri ng aktibidad lalo na sa mga hindi pa sanay sa paggamit ng mobile app. Sa pamamagitan ng personal na paggabay at malinaw na paliwanag, nagiging mas kumpiyansa silang gamitin ang teknolohiya sa kanilang pang-araw-araw na transaksyon.

Sa pagtatapos ng programa, muling iginiit ng CARD MRI ang kanilang pangako na patuloy na maghatid ng serbisyong abot-kaya at makabago para sa kanilang mga kliyente. Inaasahan din ang pagdaraos ng mas marami pang konekTAYO activities sa iba pang lugar sa bansa upang mas mapalawak ang akses sa digital banking at mas mapalakas ang kakayahan ng mga komunidad sa paggamit ng modernong teknolohiya. 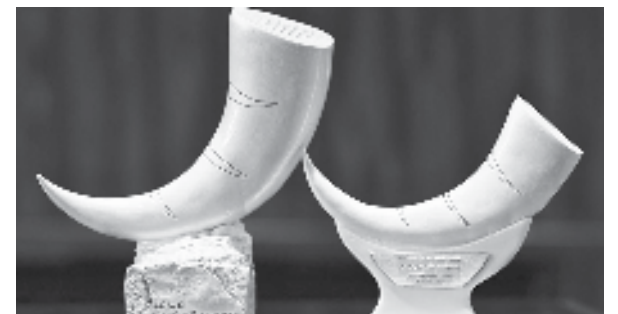
