In a landmark collaboration bridging public health and social justice, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) and the Commission on Human Rights (CHR) joined forces yesterday for a learning forum titled "Health as a Human Right: Bridging the

Healthcare Divide."

The forum brought together health and social justice leaders and civil society organizations (CSOs) to reinforce a critical principle that access to quality healthcare is a fundamental human right and a core state obligation.

Discussions focused on the urgent need to

shift the national healthcare paradigm away from purely treating illnesses toward robust, state-funded investment in preventive and primary healthcare.

The joint initiative aligns with global efforts by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Office of the United Nations High Commis-

sioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) to mainstream human rights in health governance and Universal Health Care (UHC) implementation. By anchoring domestic healthcare delivery on a rights-based framework, PhilHealth and CHR aim to improve equitable access to care especial-

Si Teresita D. Dita, 72 taong gulang, sa mga kabuhayang matiyaga nilang pinalago ng kanyang asawa: ang kanilang taniman ng punla ng lansones (kanan) at ang kanilang manukan.

Lumaki si Teresita D. Dita sa Sta. Maria, Laguna. Bagama't elementarya lamang ang natapos sa pag-aaral, maaga niyang natutuhang tumayo sa sariling mga paa. Maaga siyang naganapbuhay sa pamamagitan ng pagluluto at paglalako ng mga kakanin sa kanilang bayan kasama ang kanyang ina.

Dahil sa kaniyang paglalako at sariling paggawa, naging pamilyar ang lasa ng kaniyang mga kakanin sa kanilang komunidad, at ang kaniyang kahusayan sa paggawa ng mga ito ay kinilala sa kanilang bayan. Sa katunayan, ang kaniyang sariling gawang suman ay dalawang beses na nagwagi sa Marilag Festival, isang pagdiriwang ng agrikultura at kultura sa Sta. Maria, Laguna.

Subalit nang siya ay nagkaroon na ng sariling pamilya, hindi na naging sapat ang kita ni Teresita sa kaniyang kakanin para sa pagpapalaki ng kanilang anim na anak. Upang mapagkasya ang kita, lakas-loob na pinasimulan niya, kasama ng kaniyang asawa, ang pagmamamukan at pagbebenta ng mga itlog nito. Naging matapang ang mag-asawa na ipinuhunan ang kanilang ipon upang masimulan ang kanilang unang negosyo.

At hindi naging madali ang mga unang araw ng pag-aalaga ng manok at paghihintay sa pangangitlog nito. Kailangan din nilang mamuhunan sa pagpapanatiling ligtas ng mga manok laban sa mga peste at virus na maaaring magdulot ng sakit sa kanila.

Noong 2016, nakilala ni Teresita ang CARD, Inc. (A Microfinance NGO) at naging kliyente nito. Bilang isang bagong kliyente, kumuha siya ng kanyang unang loan na nagkakahalaga ng PHP 3,000 na siyang sumuporta sa kanilang paitlutan.

Taong 2021 naman, kumuha siya ng PHP 20,000 loan at nagdagdag ng isa pang negosyo: ang pagpapalago ng mga punla. Katulong ang kaniyang asawa. Nag-alaga sila ng mga punla ng lansones at ibinebenta ang mga ito sa halagang PHP 130 hanggang PHP 150 bawat isa.

Subalit tuwing tag-init, nagiging mahirap para sa kanila ang pag-aalaga ng mga ito dahil sa matinding init at mabilis na pagkatuyo ng lupa. Gayunpaman, patuloy nilang binantayan at diniligen nang mabuti ang mga punla. Patuloy nilang pinatubo ang mga ito kung kaya hindi natigil ang kanilang pagsu-supply hanggang sa makarating ang kanilang mga punla sa iba't ibang bahagi ng lalawigan ng Laguna at Batangas.

Tulad ng kanilang mga manok na matiyagang nag-abang sa panahon ng pangangitlog, ang buhay ni Teresita ay unti-unti na ring nagbubunga. Lahat ng kanilang mga anak ay mayroon na ngayong sariling mga pamilya, at siya ngayon ay isa nang lola sa kaniyang walong apo. Kahit na narating na niya ang ganitong yugto ng buhay, patuloy pa rin niyang pinatatakbo ang kanilang negosyo.

Kalaunan ay kumuha muli ng PHP 50,000 na loan si Teresita na kanyang hinati-hati bilang working capital para sa kanyang tatlong negosyo upang matiyak ang patuloy na operasyon at paglago ng mga ito.

Sa ngayon, kumikita sila ng halos PHP 60,000 kada buwan mula sa pagdi-distribute ng mga itlog. Dahil kilala si Teresita sa mga masarap niyang kakanin, tuloy-tuloy ang kanyang paggawa ng mga pre-order nito kung saan siya kumikita ng PHP 2,000 kada batch ng order. Ang kanilang mga punla ng lansones ay kumikita naman ng humigit-kumulang PHP 20,000 buwan-buwan.

Sapat at kontento man ang buhay niya ngayon, ngunit para kay Teresita, ang pag-abot sa ganitong yugto ay bunga ng mahabang panahon na walang patid na sipag, at matiyagang pagpapahalaga at pagpapalago sa kung ano ang mayroon sila.

Cavite ramps up health services with Php 500-M hospital upgrade

T RECE MAR-TIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) – To better serve its population of over 4.3 million, the Provincial Government of Cavite is further strengthening its public health services through modernized healthcare facilities and enhanced support for healthcare workers.

Following his inspection of local health facilities last May, Governor Francisco Gabriel Remulla announced that the Provincial Government has allotted a total of Php 500 million to upgrade the General Emilio Aguinaldo Hospital (GEAMH) and the Cavite Center for Mental Health.

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE 540-2026

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING A DRUG-FREE WORK-PLACE IN THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF CAVITE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, presented to the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, for review and consideration, is a letter from Hon. Francisco Gabriel D. Remulla, Provincial Governor;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides in part that every local government unit shall exercise the po-

wers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 468 (a)(1) of the same Act likewise provides in part that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, as the legislative body of the province, shall approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective provincial government;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 66, Series of 2018, issued by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte, calls for the institutionalization of the Philippine Anti-Ilegal Drugs Strategy, which outlines the balanced efforts of the government to strengthen the campaign against illegal drugs and contribute to international efforts to counter the worldwide illegal drug problem;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Executive Order No. 66 provides that all government entities and LGUs shall formulate and adopt their respective Drug-Free Workplace Programs and conduct authorized drug testing among their respective officials and personnel in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9165 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, as amended;

WHEREAS, Regulation No. 13, Series of 2018 issued by the Dangerous Drugs Board mandates the creation of drug-free workplace policies in all government offices, including the conduct of authorized drug testing, to ensure that all public officer remain drug free and that the general public be assured of effective and efficient service from the government;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government, through Memorandum Circular No. 2018-213 has directed local government units to strictly implement such policies, including the conduct of random drug testing, coordination with accredited laboratories;

WHEREAS, there is an imperative need to support the call of the President and the Dangerous Drugs Board and inspire active participation in the campaign against illegal trafficking and drug use in the government;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Pagulayan, Hon. Bautista and Hon. Belamide, duly seconded by all of the Members present, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

Section 1. Short Title – This Ordinance shall be known as the “Drug-Free Workplace Policy in the Provincial Government of Cavite.”

Section 2. Objective – This Ordinance aims to ensure that all public officers and personnel of the Provincial Government of Cavite, both elective and appointive, remain drug free in order to continuously provide effective and efficient service to the people.

Section 3. Scope – This Ordinance covers all elective and appointive public officers and personnel of the Provincial Government of Cavite. Contract of Service and Job Order workers are also covered by the provision of this Ordinance.

The Office of the Provincial Governor shall ensure that this Ordinance shall be properly disseminated to all offices of Provincial Government of Cavite.

Section 4. Definition of Terms The following terms are defined:

a. **Authorized Drug Testing** – the testing done by any government forensic laboratory or a drug testing laboratory accredited by the Department of Health. It shall employ, among others, two (2) testing methods, the screening test, which will determine the positive test result as well as the type of drugs used, and the confirmatory test, which shall confirm a positive screening test.

b. **Challenge Test** – a drug test conducted as a result of a challenge filed by a public officer who tested positive for drug use in confirmatory test in an authorized drug testing activity.

c. **Confirmatory Test** – an analytical test using a device, tool or equipment with a different chemical or physical principle that is more specific which will validate and confirm the result of the screening test.

d. **Dangerous Drugs** – include those listed in the Schedules annexed to the 1961 Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the 1972 Protocol, and in the Schedules annexed to the 1971 Single Convention on Psychotropic Substances as enumerated in the attached annex which is an integral part of Republic Act No. 9165 or the comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, as amended (the "Act").

e. **Drug Dependency Examination** – refers to the examination conducted by a physician accredited by the DOH to evaluate the extent of drug use of a person and to determine whether he/she is a drug dependent or not, which includes history taking, intake interview, determination of criteria for drug dependency, mental and physical status, and the detection of dangerous drugs in body specimens through laboratory procedures.

f. **Employee Assistance Program** – a program that offers assistance to government official or employees who have alcohol or drug-related issues and problems that may affect work performance. It shall be jointly implemented by the agency, the employees, and employees' union.

g. **Mandatory Drug Testing** – compulsory submission of public officer or prospective employee to drug testing as mandated by this Ordinance.

h. **Random Drug Testing** – drug testing where the selection process results in equal probability that any employee from a group of employees will be tested, and without any prior notice of the date and venue.

i. **Screening Test** – a rapid drug test performed to establish potential or presumptive positive result. It refers to the immunoassay test to eliminate a "negative" specimen, i.e. one without the presence of dangerous drugs, from further consideration and to identify the presumptively positive specimen that requires confirmatory test.

Section 5. Establishment of the Drug – Free Workplace Committee – There shall be a Drug – Free Workplace Committee which shall ensure the proper implementation and dissemination of this Ordinance. The Committee shall be composed of the following:

- a. Provincial Governor;
- b. Head of the Office of the Provincial Human Resource

Management Officer;

c. Head of the Office of the Provincial Health Officer;

d. President of the Provincial Government of Cavite Employees Association; and

e. Action / Focal Person, Provincial Government of Cavite Anti-Drug Abuse Council.

Section 6. Establishment of an Assessment Team – There shall be an Assessment Team to be created by the Provincial Governor which shall assist in the conduct of substance abuse awareness and prevention programs and implement the Employee Assistance Program for personnel who wish to undergo drug use intervention. It shall be composed of personnel with educational and training background on medicine, psychology, social work, and human resources administration.

Section 7. Aspects of the Drug – Free Workplace Policy

a. **Pre – Employment Drug Testing** – Mandatory drug testing shall remain an essential requirement for entry into government service. Any applicant found positive for drug use shall be denied entry to government service.

b. **Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention Programs** – The Assessment Team shall initiate and implement these programs to ensure that personnel are properly informed on the evils of drug use, including its physical, mental, social, and legal implications.

c. **Authorized Drug Testing** – The Drug Free Workplace Committee and or the Assessment Team shall implement a random selection procedure in order to determine personnel who shall undergo drug testing.

d. **Employee Assistance Program** – Any personnel, prior to the conduct of Authorized Drug Testing, may seek intervention through the Employee Assistance Program, which shall provide referrals and additional services to the personnel concerned. A drug dependency examination shall be conducted in order to determine the level of Substance Use Disorder and the applicable intervention. This Program shall not apply to personnel who are found to be positive for drug use after the conduct of confirmatory drug test in an Authorized Drug Testing activity.

Section 8. Guidelines in the Conduct of Authorized Drug Testing

a. The Provincial Governor, in consultation with the Drug-Free Workplace Committee, shall determine the frequency and schedule of authorized drug testing activities. All information pertaining to the timing and conduct of such testing shall be treated with the highest degree of confidentiality.

b. The manner of conducting drug testing shall strictly comply with applicable laws, rules, and regulations. Testing shall be undertaken by a duly accredited drug testing laboratory, in accordance with established protocols to ensure accuracy, integrity, and confidentiality of results. The cost of drug testing shall be borne by the Provincial Government of Cavite, unless otherwise provided by law or applicable regulations.

c. Personnel selected to undergo drug testing shall immediately report to the Drug-Free Workplace Committee, and/or the Assessment Team. Any personnel who, without justifiable reason, fails or refuses to report for drug testing shall be subject to appropriate administrative sanctions.

d. In the event that a urine sample yields a positive result for the use of dangerous drugs, as confirmed through confirmatory testing, the result shall be promptly reported to the Office of the Provincial Governor, who shall, in turn, notify the concerned public officer. The public officer shall have fifteen (15) days from receipt of such notice within which to challenge the confirmatory test result. A challenge test shall be conducted using the same specimen by a Department of Health-accredited drug testing laboratory. All expenses incurred for the challenge test shall be borne by the concerned public officer.

e. A positive result in the challenge test shall be deemed final and conclusive, and the public officer shall thereafter be subjected to appropriate administrative proceedings. Failure to file a challenge within the prescribed period shall render the confirmatory test result final, upon which the agency shall take the necessary and appropriate action.

Section 9. Sanctions

a. An appointive public officer who refuses, without any valid reason, to submit himself/herself to authorized drug testing, or is found positive for drug use after the conduct of confirmatory test in an authorized drug testing activity shall be charged with the administrative offense of Grave Misconduct.

b. Any elective public officer who refuses, without any valid reason, to submit himself/herself to authorized drug testing, or is found positive for drug use after the conduct of a confirmatory test in an authorized drug testing activity shall be subject to disciplinary action for misconduct in office pursuant to Section 60 of the Local Government Code and Article 174 (3) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Local Government Code.

c. Any public officer found to have tampered the result of a drug test, interfered with the conduct of the drug test or in the release of drug test results, or violated rules of confidentiality of records shall be charged with the administrative offense of Grave Misconduct without prejudice to the filing of a case for violation of Section 32, Article II of the Act.

d. Any public officer who violated the provisions of Article II of the Act shall be charged with the administrative offense of Grave Misconduct or face disciplinary sanction under Section 60 of the Local Government Code, as the case may be, without prejudice to the filing of criminal charges under the Act and other relevant laws.

Section 10. Funding – The Provincial Government of Cavite shall allocate a portion of its respective annual budget to fund mandatory drug testing. Such expenses may be charged against appropriate funding sources, including, but not limited to, the Local Anti-Drug Plan Action, Employee Health and Wellness Programs, the Peace and Order and Public Safety (POPS) Plan, Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) funds.

Section 11. Reporting – The Provincial Governor shall ensure that a copy of this Ordinance shall be communicated to the Dangerous Drugs Board and the Department of the Interior and Local Government for information. Thereafter, the Office of the Provincial Governor shall also report to said agencies the conduct of authorized drug testing and provide data as to the number of persons who were subjected to drug testing, the number of persons found positive for drug use, and the action undertaken by the Office of the Provincial Governor on

persons found positive for drug use.

Section 12. Separability Clause – If any part or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, other provision not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.

Section 13. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval and compliance with the posting and publication requirements.

Inaasahan itong magsilbing 24-oras na Infirmary, na mag-

bibigay ng agarang serbisyong medikal, kabilang ang emergency care, maternity services, at iba pang pangunahing serbisyong pangkalusugan.

Patunay ang proyektong ito ng ating patuloy na pagsisikap na mapabuti ang kalusugan

at kapakanan ng bawat mamamayan. Sa pamamagitan ng mas mahusay na mga pasilidad at serbisyong medikal, sama-sama nating itinataguyod ang isang mas malusog, mas ligtas, at mas maunlad na Bayan ng Indang. (BILLY DAVID SADIK NG CAVITE)
